Expectations for Use of PHS Track and for PHS Home Contests

This shared space is intended to support the efforts of the school and community.

Accessibility

- 1. This space is accessible to the public on non-student attendance days from dawn to dusk for the purpose of physical activity (walking or running on the track).
- 2. During student attendance days this space is not open to the public during the hours of 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. After school practices and contests are priorities for this space as well.
- 3. Public access is allowable after practices and contests.
- 4. Non-school groups and teams must complete a Facility Use Request to use this space.

Care of track

- 1. Bikes, golf carts, scooters, roller blades, skateboards, strollers etc. are not permitted on the track.
- 2. Food is not permitted on the track.
- 3. Folding or lawn chairs are not permitted on the track unless a tarp is in place to protect the track.

Safety

- 1. Pets are not invited to this space during the school day, after school or during school sponsored events.
- 2. Please leave this space as you found it. Trash receptacles are to be used to keep the space attractive
- 3. Spectators are not allowed to play in the ditches or tunnels around the track/field.
- 4. Spectators are not to throw footballs or other objects while on the track before, during or after
- 5. During a home contest, students (6th grade and under) are to stay in the direct supervision of their parent, guardian or caregiver during contests. Parents and guardians of unattended students will be notified regarding the expectations.
- 6. Please contact a school office or school official if you see this space being misused or if you see an issue needing to be addressed.

Civility

- 1. Fans are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during and after contests.
- 2. Fans falling short of the expectations outlined in Board Policy will be subject to ejection and restrictions for attending future contests. Ejections by an Official or Umpire will be reviewed by the Board of Education routinely.
- 3. Students disregarding the request of supervisors will be asked to sit with parents, leave the facility and/or have restrictions on attendance at future contests.

Parking

- 1. Tailgating is not allowed on Pikeland property.
- 2. Parking is not allowed on the grass east of the football field.
