Dear Parent or Guardian:

I am writing to tell you about an exciting opportunity that the Health Department of Northwest Michigan will be providing to 8<sup>th</sup> grade students at Ellsworth Community School.

During school, your child will have the opportunity to participate in a program called **You and Me, Together Vape-Free** from Stanford University School of Medicine. The You and Me, Together Vape-Free curriculum is a 5-lesson theory-based and evidence-informed curriculum created by the Stanford REACH Lab as well as a Youth Action Board, educators, healthcare providers, and scientists across the U.S.

## You and Me, Together Vape-Free includes lessons that:

- Teach students how their brain works and what happens when we introduce nicotine to the developing brain
- Help students understand the health effects of using tobacco and nicotine-containing products like e-cigarettes and cigarettes
- The harms associated with the disposal of e-cigarettes on the environment
- Help students form awareness of marketing influences and teach them skills to resist marketing tactics that encourage young consumers to use nicotine products
- Review stress and how to manage stress in a healthy way

This program is offered to your student at no cost to you during regular school hours.
