## School updates:

She is a co-chair of the Permanent Commission on the Status of Racial, Indigenous, and Tribal Populations as well as the Maine Climate Council Subcommittee on Equity. She sits on many boards of organizations with missions she is passionate about and collaborates with the Upstander Academy. She loves reading, writing, and walking her Alaskan Husky Olive. She spends her free time with her loving husband Lloyd and their three daughters Carmella, Layla, and Iris. Maulian believes in leading with love and advancing equity by finding shared humanity.
