What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual Enrollment provides the opportunity for Salisbury High School students to earn college credits at a significantly reduced tuition rate while enrolled in high school. In partnering with Moravian University & Seton Hall University, several Salisbury High School courses have been approved for college credit as these courses provide the same rigor and expectations as those taught on Moravian's and/or Seton Hall's campus.

Students can also access Lehigh Carbon Community College (LCCC) courses for dual enrollment credit. Course are offered either online or in-person on one of their campuses.

Potential Benefits of Dual Enrollment

- MU & SHU courses are taken at SHS taught by SHS faculty
- LCCC courses are taken online or at one of their campuses.
- Cost effectiveness ~ \$110.00 per credit for Seton Hall
\$100.00 per credit for Moravian
\$70.00 per credit for LCCC
- Depending on the college / university to which you are applying, Moravian / Seton Hall / LCCC credits may be transferred. Please consult with the college / university you are planning on attending regarding credit transfers.

Transferring of Credits

- Credits could be a direct transfer.
- Credits could be a “free elective” transfer.
- It is at the discretion of the college / university to which you are interested to determine what / how many credits can be accepted.
- Contact college / university admissions to inquire. Be sure to use Moravian’s / Seton Hall / LCCC’s course name.

Alumni of Dual Enrollment Report...

- Credits only; no grade for GPA.
- Course is not in my major. Dual Enrollment allowed me to satisfy an elective or other requirement.
- Satisfied my college foreign language requirement.
- Course is in my major, and Dual Enrollment allowed me to bypass an introductory level course.
- Completed my General Education requirements
- No credit awarded.

Considerations

- Cost (financial aid is not available for dual enrollment courses)
- Will the college I plan on attending accept the credits?
- Will I want to retake this course when I am at my college?
- Can I earn a C or better in this course?
- Do I test well? If so, would an AP score of 4 or 5 be accepted by my college?

Dual Enrollment Procedures / Process

- Students are only permitted to register for 3 Seton Hall courses per semester. There is no limit for Moravian University or LCCC courses.
- Students may earn no more than 22 Seton Hall credits during their SHS academic career. There is no limit for Moravian University or LCCC credits.
- Students must earn a C or better to earn Moravian / Seton Hall credit.
- Interested students must complete the appropriate registration form at:

- Registration forms need to be completed, printed and submitted to the School Counseling Office for processing.
- Payment methods vary between Moravian University & Seton Hall University.
