New Law regarding Narcan

Starting January 1st all public schools are required to have an opioid antagonist on hand in the event that an individual is experiencing a life-threatening opioid emergency. Each building has Narcan in the Main Office. It is only accessible by the Building Principal, Building Secretary, or Building Health Clerk. Parents have the right to opt their children out of having the Narcan administered to their child in the event of an opioid emergency. If you would like to opt your child out of receiving a dose of Narcan, please email the Building Principal and Building Health Clerk. Each Building Principal, Secretary, and Health Clerk will be undergoing training on how to administer Narcan in the event of an emergency.
