IAR state testing for grades 3-5

The Illinois Assessment for Readiness will begin for students in grades 3-5 when we return from Spring Break. Students will test from Wednesday, April 3rd-Friday, April 12th. We will have the week of April 15th for make ups, but students in grade 5 will also be taking the Science State test that week. PLEASE try to avoid absences for your students during the testing window. If you have appointments that you can reschedule for that time frame, please consider rescheduling. Your child's teacher will communicate with you their exact testing days. Make sure to let the teacher know if your child will be gone on any of the testing dates so we can begin working on a makeup plan. These are required state assessments that are given annually.
