



Procedures for Home Study Student Exam Registration Carroll County Schools

Georgia Senate Bill 63 requires public schools to make college and career readiness tests available to both public school students and home study students. Carroll County Schools (CCS) will provide these exams for home study students: PSAT/NMSQT, SAT school day, or Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB).

1. Who Can Participate?

- Must live in Carroll County
- Must be enrolled in a home study program (grades 9–12)
- Proof of residency required (utility bill, lease, etc.)
- All tests will take place at a Carroll County School

- **Additional Documents if Needed**

- **Fee Waivers:** Submit proof of income eligibility. [Low Income Eligibility Form](#) with registration.
- **AP Testing Proof of enrollment in AP courses:** [Course Enrollment Proof for Advanced Placement Testing](#)
- **Accommodations:** Submit IEP/504/medical documentation at least 8 weeks before the test date, and before the deadline for accommodations set by the testing company.

3. On Test Day

- **Bring a valid photo ID** (government-issued or school-issued).
- **Arrive on time** with allowed materials (pencils, calculator if permitted).
- **No electronics or unauthorized items** allowed.
- **Must follow test instructions**—violations can cancel scores and prevent future testing.
