Scholarship Granting Organization



In May of 2023, the **Thunderbird Scholarship Granting Organization** was established. The Thunderbird SGO was created to allow donors to make unrestricted contributions to benefit the students and families of Lima Central Catholic High School while also receiving eligibility for a **DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR STATE INCOME TAX CREDIT!!** It is limited to \$750 for an individual or \$1,500 if married filing jointly or the related State of Ohio tax liability.

A Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that receives contributions from donors and grants educational scholarships to eligible students in the State of Ohio. Donors (individuals and entities) that contribute to Ohio certified SGOs can receive a tax credit through the Ohio Tax Credit Program. The Ohio Tax Credit Program was enacted in 2021 as part of Ohio House Bill 110.

The **Lima Central Catholic Educational Foundation** (LCCEF) is a separate entity from the high school governed by a Board of Trustees. The LCCEF holds over \$7 million in various funds that support the mission of LCC. Its funding comes from donations, memorial gifts and other planned gifts and bequests.

Presently, there are 67 alumni or friends of LCC who have chosen to remember the LCCEF in their estate plans. Fellow Thunderbirds,

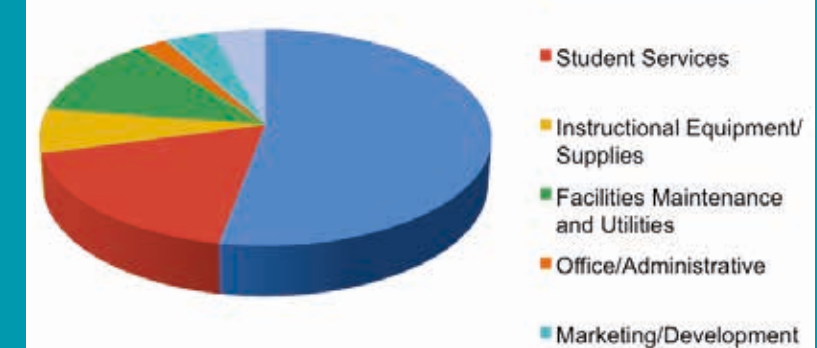
The landscape of funding our school has changed dramatically in the last few years, with new opportunities from new legislation, new challenges, along with new initiatives within the school. We want to educate our community on how it all comes together and how these changes provide opportunities for T-Bird nation to support us.

Schools are charged, and in many cases mandated, to do more for the students we serve than in previous generations. Expanded staff in guidance and intervention services are required of us to meet the 21st century needs of our school community. Initiatives in our Performing and Visual Arts programming will better serve students with talents in those areas. Keeping pace with technology will require continued investments in hardware in our labs. A nationwide shortage of educators requires us to be competitive in attracting and retaining the best faculty.

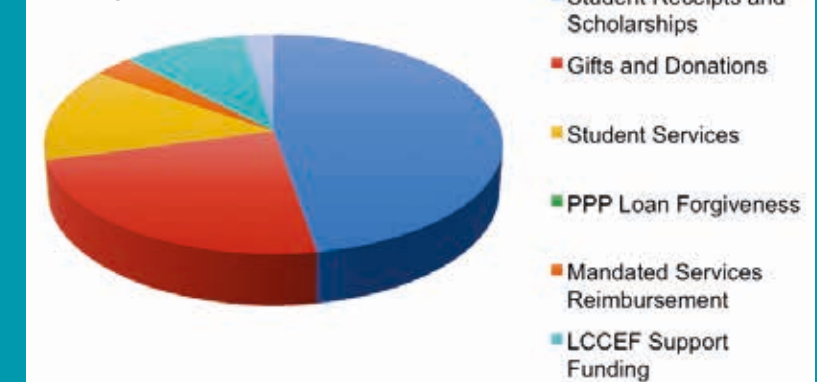
Legislation that provided Universal School Choice to Ohio, where every family is now eligible for state tuition scholarships, has helped. But the true cost to educate a student at LCC is nearly \$14,000 in the past school year, yet tuition and fees account for only about 65% of funds needed to cover that cost. Moving forward, continued enrollment growth is projected, which will help shrink that gap. Each of the initiatives explained (to the left) will play a vital role in carrying on the LCC tradition and will enhance the programming we offer.

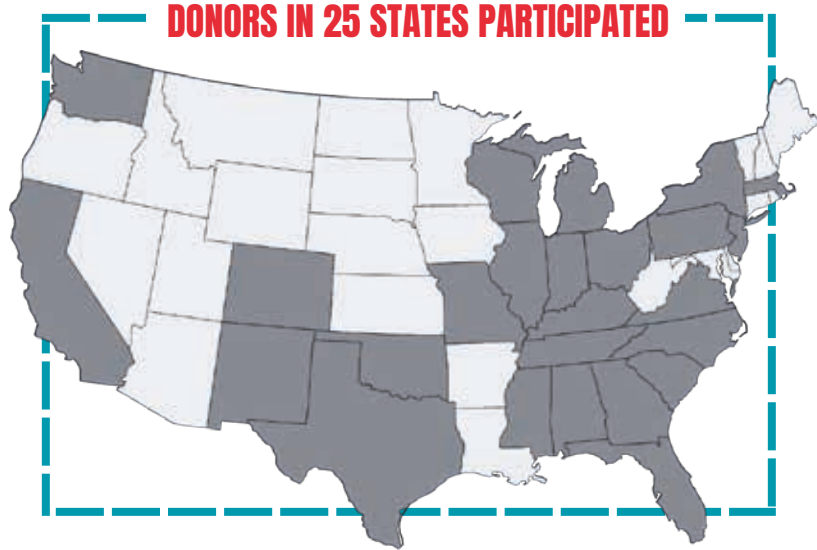

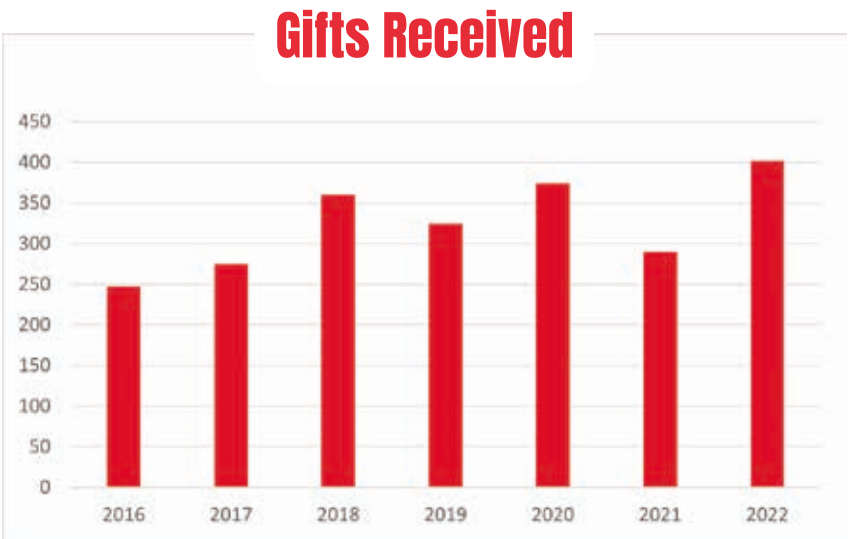
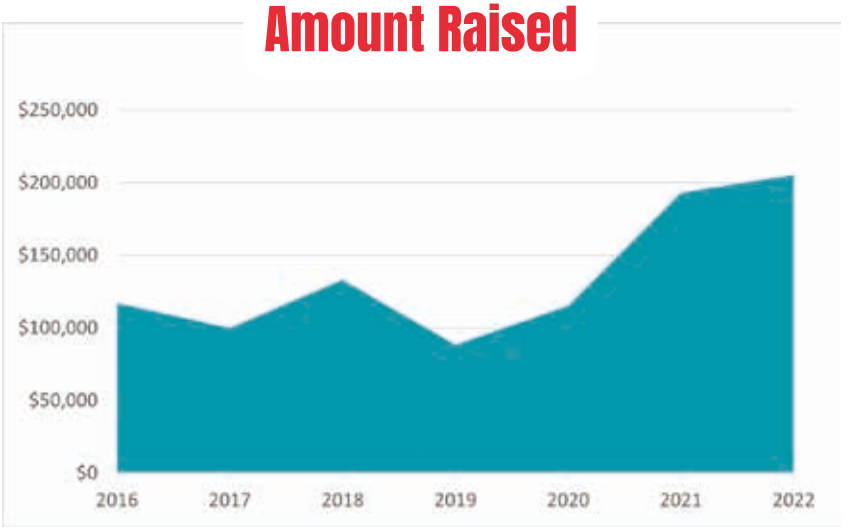

Father Herr's dachshund, T-Bird, was the first dog to walk the halls of LCC, bringing smiles to the students. Today, if you visit school, you may find Hope in the halls.

Hope is a Brittany Spaniel, a hunting dog by breed, but truly made to be a therapy dog. She is certified through the Alliance of Therapy Dogs. Jessica Gronas, her handler and School Counselor, put in countless hours of training to make sure Hope would pass the test and be the best therapy dog out there! She has the best of both worlds: having Hope at home as a pet and seeing her with students at school bringing smiles all day long.

Hope is now a fixture at LCC, and the guidance counselors say that having her around has helped their department reach out to more students than before.

"Everyone here pretty much loves Hope. Usually, when they walk by, they always have a smile on their face, and there's been a lot of people that just go up, pet her for a couple of minutes, and go to their classes. I feel like it really relieves some stress," says Bryce Williams, a student at LCC.

"Hope definitely makes our environment more comforting and calm. She has an ability to be there for people, calm their anxieties and make them smile. The smiles have been my favorite. Seeing students walk by and smile at her is pure joy. I also love seeing students get down to pet her. Students who may not have visited guidance before, have been more likely to come build relationships with us because they come to see Hope. Having Hope here has definitely opened up lines of communication and deeper bonds with students," explained Jessica.

Hope's presence at LCC has had a profound impact on the school community. With her gentle and affectionate nature, she has become a beloved figure, spreading joy and comfort to students and staff alike. The genuine happiness and deeper connections she has facilitated have left a lasting mark on LCC, reminding us all of the incredible power of a furry friend like Hope.

Q&A WITH JESSICA

"I have always loved dogs. I had heard of therapy dogs being available in hospitals, nursing homes and other various places. I LOVED the idea of being able to bring a dog to schools. I had been in my career as a counselor for two years and already learned that sometimes words can't be used during hard times. One of the best things you can do is just be present. What could be more comforting than a dog when you're having a difficult time?"

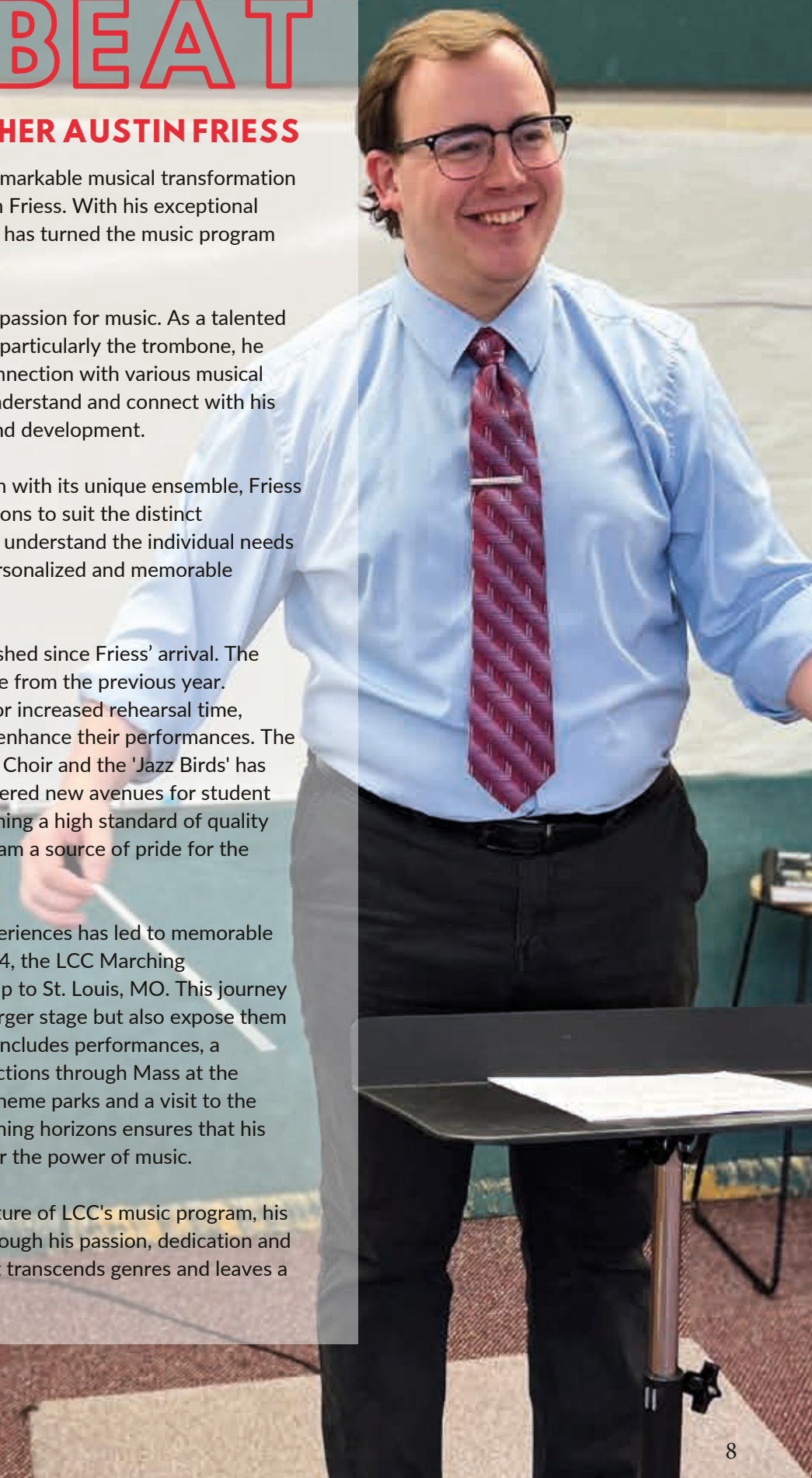

MEET THE NEW COACHES



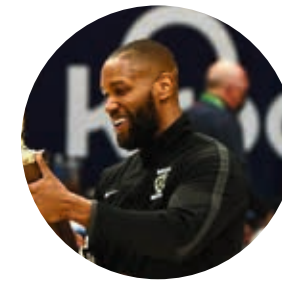
Eric Kuhlman

RACHAEL O'CONNOR DENGLER '10

With nine years of experience in education, Rachael Dengler, has held various teaching positions before becoming the principal of St. Thomas Aquinas School in Cleveland, Ohio.

Rachael's time at LCC played a pivotal role in her decision to pursue a career in education. She recalls, "I have always loved learning, especially when it involved a lot of reading. I had a really positive experience at LCC with plenty of teachers who valued my academic growth, so I ended my time at LCC with a desire to be a person who could also help someone else grow in their own way."

One teacher who left a lasting impact on Rachael was Ms. Williams, her American History teacher during freshman year. Rachael remembers Ms. Williams as the first teacher who truly wanted to know her as a person, not just a student. This personal connection made Rachael feel understood and seen during her high school years. Ms. Williams continues to be a friend and mentor to Rachael, providing guidance and support throughout her career in education.

Rachael now leads St. Thomas Aquinas Elementary School, facing numerous challenges inherent to the field of education. She notes that educators must navigate the uncertainties of not knowing the personal struggles students bring into the classroom each day. The constant need for adaptation and adjustments is a hallmark of the profession, as educators strive to provide an equitable learning environment for all.

To those entering the education field, Rachael offers valuable advice: "Remember your why. Remember why you chose the field, why your students deserve your time and commitment. Remember why leading with empathy and love is right." Rachael emphasizes that education is an ever-evolving field, and both educators and students are continually learning. Being a positive influence in young people's lives is a privilege that should never be taken for granted.

When asked about her hopes for her students, Rachael's response reflects her deep commitment to their personal growth and well-being: "I hope our students feel loved, known, and valued when they leave our school. I hope they know that they are capable of doing hard things, and worthy of the joys that come when they accomplish their goals."

Inspiring Minds Through the Education Field



TAYLOR SHULTZ PURDY '15

A Beacon of Support and Guidance at Lima Central Catholic High School

While academic success remains important, there is now a growing recognition of the significance of mental health.

Taylor Purdy, a graduate of the Class of 2015, has returned to her alma mater as a school counselor, embarking on a mission to provide support to the students who walk the same path she once did.

Purdy recognized the invaluable role of school counselors in a student's life. She understood the impact they could have on shaping a student's future, and it became her aspiration to be that person for others.

Purdy acknowledges the importance of her profession while humbly acknowledging its limitations. "The biggest challenge of someone in a helping profession is that sometimes you feel like there isn't enough that you can do," she explains. "As people, we like to fix things, but sometimes you just have to be there for others and know that that's enough."

Taylor has noticed a shift in focus within the field of education, compared to when she was in school. While there is still an emphasis on academic success, there is a growing recognition and concern for the mental health and well-being of our students.

"We are addressing the mental health component at LCC by individual counseling, small group sessions, connecting students to resources and outside services, incorporating suicide awareness and prevention curriculum and lastly working together with teachers, staff and families to help support our students!"

She is hopeful that in the future, society can continue to recognize students as people first and place a greater emphasis on their abilities as a whole versus their score on a test.

No two days are the same as a school counselor. Purdy recognizes the significance of self-care in being successful in her role. Drawing a parallel to the safety instructions on an airplane, she emphasizes the importance of putting on one's own mask first before assisting others. By prioritizing her well-being, Purdy ensures that she can continue to provide the best support to her students, helping them navigate the challenges they face.

By valuing each individual student and fostering a nurturing environment, Lima Central Catholic and its dedicated staff like Purdy are helping to shape the next generation with empathy and understanding.

PAUL DE PALMA, PH.D. '65

Paul De Palma, Ph.D., Chair and Professor of Computer Science at Gonzaga University, has wonderful memories of his youth in Lima and his days at LCC.

"I was a kid during the post-Sputnik era. There was a great concern that the Soviet Union would surpass the United States in engineering and science. Mr. Ireland, the physics teacher at LCC, developed a science program that recruited 8th graders from the parish schools. Each Saturday morning, my friends and I trekked from the south side to study science at LCC. I felt like I was being let in on the secrets of the universe. It is hard to imagine a more creative and dedicated teacher than Mr. Ireland. My life would have been very different without him," states De Palma.



These beginnings in Lima inspired a 33 year career in education. When De Palma first began teaching, the professor's job was to dispense information. Today, they are encouraged to engage the students as active learners, and partners in the learning process. As a professor in Computer Science, De Palma acknowledges the challenges posed by the rapid changes in his field. The text he uses to teach computational linguistics has changed completely since he first began using it a decade ago. De Palma and other colleagues are forced to learn with and alongside their students. He spends his summers retraining to keep up with the constantly evolving field.

De Palma has fond memories of LCC figures who molded his path. Fr. Ricker, a priest at St. Charles at the time, instilled in him an appreciation for the richness of Roman Catholicism. Fr. Siefker, the vice-principal, introduced him to Latin, laying the foundation for De Palma's research in computer processing of human language. Sister Ann Louise, his trigonometry teacher, left an enduring mark by expressing confidence in his ability to pursue college-level mathematics, a memory that still resonates over half a century later and Fr. Herr, provided invaluable encouragement to him during his time in undergraduate school in the late 60's.

De Palma has remained focused in his career and has found education to be a "joy (and a privilege) to engage with bright young people, to work on problems for which answers are unknown, and to collaborate with colleagues across disciplines".

When asked what he wishes for his students, De Palma said "I hope they will bring a sense of social responsibility to their work. I hope that they will look critically at technology. Not all things that are fun to develop should be developed."

De Palma's passion and enthusiasm for teaching is a reminder of the influence educators can have on the lives of their students, undoubtedly positioning him as the Mr. Ireland to countless of his own students.



Chris O'Brien '08

Chris O'Brien, a 2008 graduate of Lima Central Catholic, has dedicated his career to the field of education. Dr. Thomas Ebner '59

Dr. Tom Ebner, a proud alumnus of Lima Central Catholic High School, has dedicated his life to serving others and expressing his gratitude for the blessings he has received. Born to Claude and Virginia Ebner in Lima, Ohio, Tom's upbringing in a loving Catholic family laid the foundation for his strong faith and values. He credits his parents for instilling in him a deep sense of gratitude and a commitment to giving back.

As a member of the Class of 1959, Tom fondly reminisces about his high school days, emphasizing the strong bond and camaraderie among his classmates. High school was a time of joy and fun, and one particular person who made a significant impact on Tom's life was Sr. Catherine Therese, his favorite teacher at Lima Central Catholic. Sr. Catherine's exceptional teaching in math and physics prepared Tom for his future in medicine at Ohio State University.



Another unforgettable encounter was with a local troublemaker who was shot in the neck with a Masai arrow while attempting to steal from a neighbor's garden. Tom and his team performed a surgical procedure to remove the arrow, and miraculously, the man suffered no neurological deficits. Witnessing a man walking around with an arrow in his neck was an extraordinary event that remained etched in Tom's memory.

In addition to his medical endeavors, Tom found inspiration in the Camino de Santiago pilgrimage. After watching the movie "The Way" starring Martin Sheen, he and a retired cardiologist friend decided to embark on the 500-mile journey from Port St Jean in France to Santiago, Spain. Over five weeks, they hiked 15-20 miles each day, cherishing the beautiful landscapes and relishing the opportunity to meet fellow pilgrims.

While the physical challenge of the Camino de Santiago was present, Tom emphasizes that it was not a spiritual retreat. Nevertheless, the journey allowed ample time for prayer, contemplation, and connection with other pilgrims. Tom completed the pilgrimage at the age of 76, demonstrating that age should never be a barrier to pursuing meaningful experiences.

Tom Ebner's life exemplifies the power of gratitude and the joy of serving others. From his humble beginnings in Lima to his inspiring medical work in Kenya and his transformative pilgrimage on the Camino de Santiago, Tom's story is one of faith, resilience, and unwavering dedication to making a difference.

Deron Bender '89

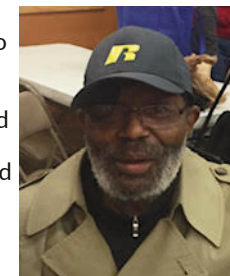
Deron Bender has woven his faith into action by serving the homeless through Manna Cafe. His journey began 11 years ago when Ohio weathered two brutal polar vortices. Amid the flurry of organizations concerned with animal welfare during the storms, Bender's heart turned to a different group, the homeless population, leading him to a path of remarkable impact.

Bender's involvement started with a single act of kindness. Seeing a friend's post about delivering meals and supplies to the homeless community, he was inspired to take action. Soon, Deron found himself cooking meals out of his home for a local shelter pantry that lacked the resources for on-site meal preparation.

From that initial leap of kindness, a ripple effect emerged. Bender initially funded the meals himself, joined by a few friends. However, as the homeless population grew, so did the need for meals. Friends, families, and various groups joined hands to sponsor meals, forming a beautiful alliance of compassion. This spirit of giving even touched the Lima Central Catholic community, particularly the classes of 1989 and 1990, who joined to honor lost classmates through sponsoring meals.

Manna Cafe became a canvas for Bender's faith to come alive. Engaging with the homeless community, hearing their stories of resilience amid adversity, enriched his faith journey. Diverse backgrounds converged in service, reinforcing the shared values of compassion and humanity.

One of the first people Deron met 11 years ago was Mr. Robert Gibbs. Gibbs's journey to homelessness happened abruptly when his wife and mother's passing led to overdue bills and a legal dispute with a family member over property ownership.



Devoid of a cell phone, Deron offered to make calls to Gibbs's lawyer and city contacts. He needed \$800 to cover court fees and utility bills and after a Facebook post telling the story, funds were raised in less than 1 hour. Within days, Mr. Gibbs was back in his property. For several years he returned to the shelter every week to thank Deron and the other volunteers.

Bender's commitment echoes the ethos of Lima Central Catholic, where everyone is valued. That, along with his father's (Michael Bender '58) teachings, rooted in the idea that no one is more important than another, have fueled Deron's mission to uplift the marginalized.

Deron's journey reflects the immense impact one individual can create when guided by compassion and empathy. His story speaks to the essence of faith in action, reminding us that the road to enriching our faith often lies in extending a hand to those who need it most.

HONORING THUNDERBIRDS FOR 35 YEARS



Danielle Taflinger Spragg '10 Athletic Achievement

Graduating in 2010, Danielle Spragg attended Lima Central Catholic where she excelled in multiple sports. As a 12-time varsity letter winner, Danielle was a key contributor and leader for the girls' volleyball team, leading them to consecutive state tournament appearances and winning the only girls' volleyball state championship in school history during her sophomore year. She received accolades such as Conference Player of the Year and two-time 1st Team All-State selection. In basketball, she ranks 13th on the career scoring list, and in track, she was a district champion in the high jump and a four-time district champion in the 300 hurdles.

At Lima Central Catholic, Danielle was also a member of the National Honor Society and received academic awards. She was honored as the 2010 Lima News Female Scholar Athlete of the Year. Continuing her education on a volleyball scholarship at The University of Findlay, Danielle had an exceptional collegiate career. She played in all 433 sets during her four years, earning a spot in the university's record books for

career, season, and individual records. With 1,118 kills, she ranks 10th in school history, and her hitting percentage of .347 is the second highest in school history. She was named 1st Team All GLIAC, All-Midwest Region, and a two-time All-American during her junior and senior seasons. Danielle concluded her time at UF by receiving the prestigious GLIAC Commissioner's award and the Mancuso Award, recognizing her outstanding performance on the court, in the classroom, and in the community.

Throughout her athletic journey, Danielle cherished the support and guidance she received from her coaches, staff, and teammates. She holds fond memories of the Lima Central Catholic community, which had a profound impact on her life.

Lawrence A. Huffman '71 Community Service

Lawrence A. Huffman is a graduate of the LCC class of 1971. After serving in the Marines, he joined the American Legion and has remained active with the organization throughout his life. He played a key role in the establishment of the Veterans' Memorial Wall at LCC, which honors the service and sacrifice of Lima Catholic School Veterans.

Huffman is also a student of the Medal of Honor, the highest military decoration awarded by the United States. He has given numerous talks about the Medal of Honor and its recipients, sharing his knowledge and passion with others. He even arranged for two Medal of Honor recipients, Patrick Brady in 2005 and Woody Williams in 2011, to visit Lima, and educate local students and parents about valor.

In addition to his work with the American Legion and his espousal of Medal of Honor recipients, Huffman has also been involved with the Allen County Museum, where he serves on the board of directors. He organized the Medal of Honor display at the museum, showcasing the stories of those who have received this distinguished honor.

He has also been involved in other community projects, such as raising funds for the William E. Metzger memorial at the Metzger Reservoir in Lima, which was an Eagle Scout project and securing overhead flags for the new gymnasiums at LCC and Lima Senior in 2003 and 2004. Overall, Huffman is a dedicated and committed member of his community, passionate about serving others and making a difference in the world.

Christina Guagenti Christensen '66 Professional Achievement

Chris Christensen's illustrious journalism career spanned over 50 years, marked by its impressive longevity and her extensive experience and achievements.

In 1966, during her senior year at LCC, Chris took a creative writing class that set the course for her professional journey. She chose to profile Hope Strong, a popular local columnist for The Lima News, and her insightful work left a lasting impression on Strong, who offered her a job after graduation.

Chris started at her hometown paper. Her breakthrough came in December 1966 when Strong invited her to interview the Yardbirds, an emerging English rock band. She vividly remembers her encounter with the band members, including a young Jimmy Page.

After Hope Strong's untimely passing in the 1970s, Chris became the editor of the section until she moved to Dayton in 1979. Joining the Dayton Daily News, she assumed the role of Lifestyle editor until the late 1980s when she relocated to Southern California.

Chris's career continued to flourish as she wrote freelance features for the Los Angeles Times and edited political cartoons by Herb Block. She also worked on Ann Landers' pieces for an LA newspaper syndicate before becoming an assistant entertainment editor at the Press-Telegram in Long Beach. Thriving in the role, she became the paper's food editor and garnered numerous awards from the Association of Food Journalists for her exceptional columns, features, and sections. Chris embraced the opportunity to write a local column, covering significant events like the Los Angeles riots, Bill Clinton's controversies, and the O.J. Simpson murder trial.

In 1999, Chris and her husband relocated to Portland for their roles at The Oregonian newspaper. She returned to her passion for food writing and editing, earning acclaim as a finalist for a James Beard Award in 2002 for her wine story, "A Winner by the Nose." As The Oregonian's Food Editor, she received the Best Section award from the Association of Food Journalists, solidifying Portland's reputation as a culinary destination through interviews with esteemed chefs like Anthony Bourdain and Thomas Keller.

Later, Chris moved back to Southern California in 2004 and joined Orange Coast Magazine as a Senior Editor, contributing to its accolades in food, fashion, and home design. She retired from the magazine in June 2018, cherishing her career, particularly its early days.

The tenth of eleven Quatman children, Ed has been a part of our Catholic community his entire life. He attended St. Charles School, is a 1973 graduate of Lima Central Catholic, and a 1977 graduate of Adrian College.

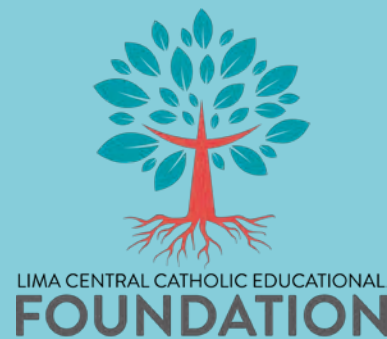
