2013 1 2 **Violation of Board Ethics** 3 The board of education is responsible for enforcing the code of ethics of its 4 members. If any member of the board commits a serious or repeated 5 violation of the code, the board may take any of the following steps: 6 7 8 1. The board president may confer with the board member who has 9 violated the code of ethics in order to: 10 11 Identify the provision of the code that the member has violated; 12 13 Propose how the member can remedy the violation; 14 c. If the board member who violated the code is the board 15 16 president, the vice president is empowered to confer with the 17 president about the violation. 18 19 The board may discuss the violation as an agenda item at a meeting to 20 confront the offending board member. However, the board will not enter closed session to hold the discussion of the ethics violation 21 22 unless the Open Meetings Act authorizes a closed session. 23 24 3. The board may vote to publicly censure any board member who 25 commits a serious or repeated violation of the code.
