2	Relationship with District Legal Counsel
3	
4	The board will engage legal counsel to assist it and the administration in
5	dealing with legal issues. When the district faces circumstances in which
6	legal counsel may be needed between board meetings, the board
7	president or superintendent may engage legal counsel on the board's
8 9	behalf.
10	The superintendent and the board president shall have the authority to
11	contact the school's attorney on behalf of the district. The superintendent
12	may give other members of the administration permission to contact the
13	school's attorney on an as-needed basis. Individual board members other
14	than the president may not contact the school attorney on behalf of the
15	board without the approval of a majority of the board.
16	
17	Any board member who contacts the school attorney without board
18 19	approval may be personally responsible for any legal fees incurred as a result of the unapproved contact.
20	result of the unapproved contact.
21	The superintendent will, to the extent permitted by law, keep the board
22	informed of matters in which the school attorney is involved.
