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660.05 DUTY TO KEEP SIDEWALKS IN REPAIR AND CLEAN.

- (a) The owners and/or occupants of lots or land abutting sidewalks, curbing and gutters within the corporate limits of the City shall keep such sidewalks, curbing and gutters in good repair and free from snow or any nuisance at all times.
- 1. The following will be used as the criteria when deciding to enforce repairs:
 - (a) Adjoining sections or parts thereof whose edges differ vertically by more than one-half inch.
 - (b) Adjoining sections with open joints greater than one-half of an inch in width.
 - (c) Sections that are cracked so that pieces are missing or loose.
 - (d) Sections sloping away from the street unless so constructed by design.
 - (e) Sections with cross-slopes exceeding three-fourths inches vertical per one foot horizontal (6.25% maximum).
 - (f) Sidewalk without a continuous unobstructed width of 4 feet.
 - (g) Sections that cause an abrupt change in the longitudinal grade of the sidewalk.
 - (h) Sections with deteriorating surfaces presenting loose aggregate.
 - (i)Sections containing structures such as cellar doors, grates, water boxes, meter pits, which protrude above the sidewalk more than one-half inch so that they present a tripping hazard.
 - (j)Sidewalk constructed without approval of the City.
 - (k) Other conditions causing an unsafe surface in the opinion of the authorized City personnel.
- (b) Owners and/or occupants of lots or lands who fail to comply with division (a) of this section shall be liable for all the natural and probable consequences of such failure, including injury or damage to persons or property, which injury or damage is proximately caused by such failure.
- (c) Whenever it appears that such owners and/or occupants have failed to keep the sidewalks, curbing and gutters in good repair, the Council may, by ordinance or resolution, order repairs to be made in accordance with Ohio R.C. 729.01 to 729.12.
- (d) (d) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.
