16. PM Car Rider Line - We have had more PM car riders this school year. Let's all work together to use ALL three lanes for dismissal. Please note, if you are parking in the second lane (middle lane), please do not block the space before the narrow two lane curve until lane three (lane closest to the parked cars) is full. When we don't use all three lanes we end up with multiple cars that cannot fit in our regular car rider line which results in confusion, a slower dismissal, and students and parents/guardians walking through the side lot to a car. Let's all commit to following our dismissal procedures so we can keep all Wildcats safe! Also, to put it in perspective, the bell rings at 3:40 signaling dismissal. Our 5-11 year old students leave their class, exit the building, load their car, and lanes get checked by 3:45-3:46. That means we are ready to safely exit the car rider lines within 6 minutes since dismissal. That is about as fast as any car rider dismissal out there! Thank you for your help and attention to our procedures.
