Facilities Funding Update

It has now been a year since we completed construction of the most recent phase (Phase 3) of the Facilities Master Plan – *the Coach Herm and Jackie Bachrodt Athletic Complex*. I thought this would be a good time to provide an update on that project, as well as a brief summary of the construction projects that preceded it.



Having recently started the second year using the new athletic complex, it is easy to look back and realize that it is a special place – for our student athletes (competitive teams and PE classes), our coaches, our fans, and the overall Kapaun Mt. Carmel community. During its first year, we drew great crowds for our varsity volleyball, wrestling and basketball events; in fact, out of the ten basketball evenings we hosted, our old gym probably would not have accommodated the crowds we drew for seven or eight of the games. Attendance at this fall's volleyball games has also been strong, and would have certainly stretched the seating capacity of our old gym.

Of great importance, as well, are the artificial turf on the football field, the new 8-lane track, and various other improvements of the outdoor athletic fields.

The new athletic complex complements beautifully the student commons we completed in 2007 as part of Phase 2 of the Master Plan. Together, they provide space that will accommodate the social and athletic activities of the Kapaun Mt. Carmel community for the next several generations, both for every day events such as student dining, games, and socializing, and for special events such as dances, banquets, tournaments, etc.

Going all the way back to 2002, we completed Phase 1 of the Facilities Master Plan which was anchored by the construction of the new Science and Technology Wing and the refurbishment of the original academic wing. Our students today are well-served by the new science classrooms, technology classrooms, media center and the large chapel in the lower level.

The total cost of the projects approaches \$16 million which was funded through the generosity of hundreds of dedicated people in the KMC community. Of that amount, approximately \$3.1 million remains outstanding on our diocesan construction loan. While interest rates are very favorable at present, it would help our operating budget greatly to pay off the loan as quickly as possible. I would much rather invest in teacher salaries, technology, learning materials, etc. than to pay interest on a loan. Therefore, I am asking everyone who has a balance remaining on their pledges to consider accelerating future pledge payments or to pay off their remaining commitments as soon as possible.

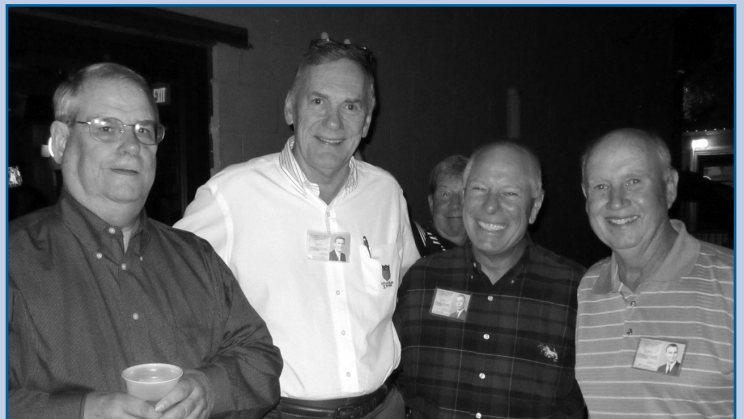

Remember KMC - IRA Rollover Opportunity

Time is of the essence! The Tax Relief, Unemployment Insurance Reauthorization, and Job Creation Act was reenacted in late December, 2010. The bill restored the popular IRA Charitable Rollover that was first enacted in 2006, but was allowed to expire. It was retroactively restored for 2010 and extended until December 31, 2011. This bill did not receive widespread attention from the media.

Without this extension, a distribution from your IRA is taxed as ordinary income. Through the remainder of calendar year 2011 this provision permits taxpayers aged 70 ½ and older to donate up to \$100,000 directly from their IRAs to qualified charities without having to account for the distributions as taxable income.

To put this in more practical terms, let's take a look at Mr. Pete Pension's circumstance. Pete is a 71 year old retiree with \$600,000 in his IRA. Because of another pension that he receives, he doesn't need this money for living expenses. However, because of his age, he is required to take a mandatory distribution every year and pay taxes on it. Pete's required minimum distribution in 2011 would be \$22,641.51 and is taxed at a rate of 25% resulting in taxes of \$6,410. Pete potentially could rollover up to \$100,000 from his IRA without being taxed but he makes the decision to gift his required distribution to his parish. In essence, he has transferred his potential taxable amount from a gift to the government to a gift to the Church. Due to the extension of this bill, the mandatory distribution does not count as part of his taxable income and Pete is not required to itemize on his tax return to receive the benefit.

At the time of this writing, it is unknown if this bill will be extended through 2012. If you would like to remember Kapaun Mt. Carmel Catholic High School with an IRA rollover, please contact Kevin Arkin in the KMC Development Office.

KMC Alumni and Friends Develop Fisch Haus

Perhaps you have heard about Final Friday, Wichita's art gallery crawl. As its name suggests, it takes place on the last Friday of every month. This event allows local artists the opportunity to display their artwork at a variety of locations around Old Town including, Exploration Place, City Arts and various other galleries in the Wichita downtown area.

One popular venue to visit during Final Friday is the Fisch Haus Studios. Fisch Haus (pronounced Fish House) is a multi-disciplinary art facility, located in Wichita's Commerce St. Art District, currently accommodating five full-time local artists as well as a steady stream of artists and musicians, both regional and international.

In 1990 three KMC alumni, Patrick Duegaw '84, John Ernatt '85, Eric Schmidt '84, and their friend, Kent Williams, founded The Artist Cooperative. Since 1993, it has operated out of a three story warehouse that contains studio and gallery space, small businesses, a full wood and metal shop and a graphic design studio.

The Fisch Haus produces several large-scale shows annually, and hosts numerous community art events, ranging from visiting artist exhibitions and performances, to lectures, classes, benefits, readings, and music festivals throughout the rest of the year; most all of which are offered free of charge and are open to all ages.

All four men are well-known in Wichita for their artistic endeavors.

which strives to broaden appreciation of Wichita's contemporary art scene.

Ernatt is also a full-time artist who owns Diver Studio, at 424 S. Commerce, with his wife, Connie, an artist whose recent work includes the bronze memorial to fallen law enforcement officers at City Hall. Their studio was the first site of Fisch Haus, which later moved a block south down Commerce.

Schmidt and Williams still have studios at Fisch Haus. Williams is well-known for public art around Wichita and for urban and architectural design as well as his own art.

Schmidt has designed a sound hole for guitar that is sold in music shops, and is also exploring wind energy and aerodynamic enhancements for vehicles. His wife, Jamie Tabor, created the Chicken Poop brand of lip balm and runs her business out of the Fisch Haus.

KAPAUN MT. CARMEL 2010-11 ANNUAL REPORT

Dear Alumni and Friends,

I am pleased to report on the fiscal operations of Kapaun Mt. Carmel Catholic High School for the 2010-11 school year. The figures and graphs for both revenue and expenses are shown below.

First, it is important to note the critical role that Catholic stewardship plays in the overall financing of the school. The Catholic Diocese of Wichita has made Catholic education such a high priority that it has committed to provide a tuition-free, K-12 education for the children of its families who are dedicated to a stewardship way of life – time, talent and treasure. With the total cost of education averaging more than \$5,800 per student, our school families would have to pay at least that amount in tuition and fees from their own financial resources without the support of their parishes' dedicated stewards just for the normal operations of the school. That amount would not provide funding for the construction or upgrading of KMC's campus, which has amounted to almost \$16 million in the past ten years. We are indeed blessed to have access to quality, Catholic faith-based education for our children, and to have generous donors who have stepped forward to fund campus improvements.

For the 2010-11 fiscal year, 77% of KMC's revenue was provided by the parishes to which our students and their families belong. In addition to the support of our parishes, significant revenue was also provided by the various fees (totaling \$740 per student) that are paid by all families (11% of total revenue), and by our development activities (6% of total revenue) through the charitable gifts of our parents, students, faculty and staff, alumni, parents of alumni, grandparents, and other friends of the school; the development revenue does not include donations that were received for KMC's physical facilities.

From an expense standpoint, 48% was spent directly on instructional costs, primarily faculty salaries; regrettably, none of the KMC faculty or staff received pay increases during this fiscal year. The next largest expenditures were for the operation of our expanded facilities, at 18%. It is important to note that interest of \$95,000 that was incurred on our loan for the construction of the *Coach Herm and Jackie Bachrodt Athletic Complex* (all of which was covered by funds donated through the KMC Development Department) is included in that amount.

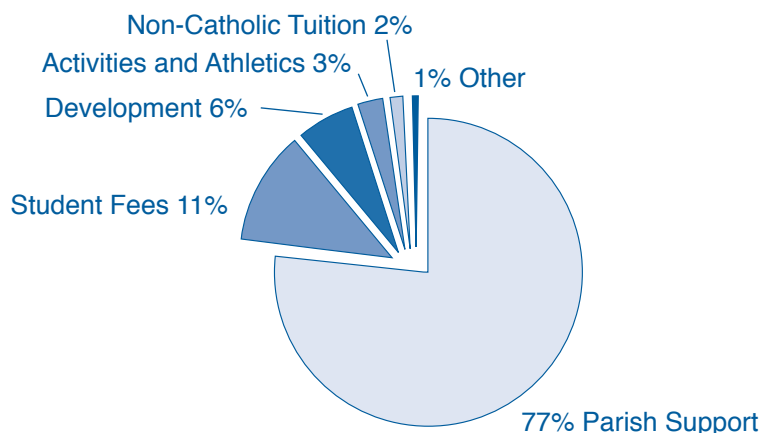
General and administrative expenses accounted for 12% of our costs, while the funding of benefits for our employees amounted to 11% of total expense. Smaller, but very critical items included athletics and activities at 7%, and communications and development at 3%.

In spite of the economic conditions, we've been able to continue the pursuit of our mission "to educate and form the total person in the image of Jesus Christ." On behalf of all our current and future students, I want to offer my appreciation to all of our supporters who made gifts of every size and kind this past year to help fund the operations of Kapaun Mt. Carmel Catholic High School – whether financially, or as one of our many, valued volunteers. Special appreciation goes to our parish pastors for their undying spirit of commitment to Catholic education and to KMC.

We truly appreciate your ongoing support, and look forward to a successful 2011-12 school year.

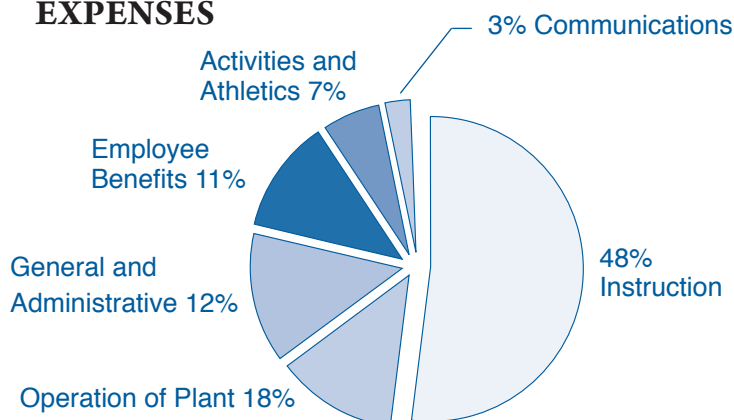
