KMC Hall of Fame

November 20, 2010 was a special day in the history of Kapaun Mt. Carmel Catholic High School. That evening, the fourth KMC Hall of Fame dinner and induction ceremony since the Hall of Fame's inception in 1992 were held. The KMC commons was a wonderful venue for the festivities, and the catered dinner was delightful. Almost 220 members of the Kapaun Mt. Carmel community were in attendance to honor the four new KMC Hall of Fame inductees. The flow of the evening was coordinated by Master of Ceremonies **Matt Schlapp**.



Msgr. Charles Regan, a long-time superintendent of Catholic schools in the diocese, as well as a parish pastor, was introduced by our good friend, Msgr. William Carr. Msgr. Regan reflected on the tremendous commitment our diocese has made to Catholic education, and on some of the joys and challenges he experienced during his 15 years as the superintendent.

John Kornelson, who is more familiarly known as J.K., was the most successful track coach in KMC's history; in recent years, he has re-joined the KMC track coaching staff and also now serves as KMC's head cross country coach. One of his former star athletes, and now a KMC parent – Mark Ayres – formally introduced J.K. They both shared fond memories about the success of the teams of the 1970's, and Mark was sincere in reciting J.K.'s personal qualities that have served him so well during his high school and college coaching career.

Brent Knott, who spent his entire 34-year career as an art teacher at Kapaun Mt. Carmel, could not attend personally. But, Brent expressed his personal gratitude for being inducted into the KMC Hall of Fame via a video presentation. His continued love of the school was evident as he related stories about his hiring (by Sr. Kathleen Gilbert) and about a life's lesson he learned from fellow Hall of Fame inductee, John Kornelson. Brent was honored to have his friend, KMC Principal David Kehres, introduce him and the video presentation.

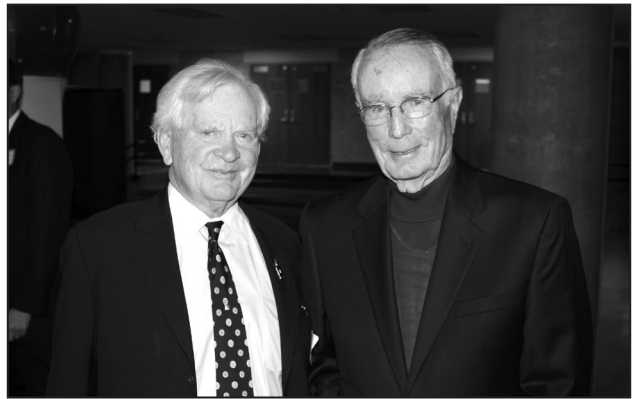
Hi Lewis, who gained notoriety as one of the best athletes in the history of Chaplain Kapaun Memorial High School, spoke from an interesting perspective. He is both a former Crusader athlete, and the father of a current KMC athlete (Keaton is a standout on the football field and the basketball court). Hi's remarks included plenty of reminiscing about the distant past, and also reflections about the commitments required in order for athletes, coaches and their teams to be highly successful. In introducing him, Hi's lifelong friend, Grier Jones, shared interesting anecdotes about their days together as Kapaun students.

As enjoyable and entertaining as the dinner and induction ceremony were, it was the guest speakers

who clearly captured the attention of every person in attendance. Two former POW's who served with Fr. Emil Kapaun in Korea – **Mike Dowe** from Houston and **Bob Wood** from St. Louis – shared their testimony (sometimes with great emotion) about the man who is a namesake of Kapaun Mt. Carmel Catholic High School. In their minds, Fr. Kapaun is clearly a saint and is deserving of canonization by the Church. Dowe's and Woods' discussions were led by **Travis Heying**, who was the director, and a producer and editor of the Wichita Eagle's 2009 video tribute "The Miracle of Father Kapaun". Everyone who was able to attend the dinner was indeed fortunate to experience the presence of Fr. Kapaun through these special guests.



In kicking off the evening's activities, it was my privilege to offer some opening remarks. Sadly, I acknowledged the passing of three KMC Hall of Fame members who have died since the last Hall of Fame event was held in 2004.

- Our friend and longtime coach, athletic director, teacher and mentor, **Ed Kriwiel**, died in December, 2007.
- **Sr. Kathleen Gilbert, BVM**, who served the longest tenure as principal of Kapaun Mt. Carmel in its 40-year history, passed away in October, 2009.
- Former basketball coach, athletic director and teacher at Chaplain Kapaun Memorial High School in the 1950's and 1960's, **Herm Bachrodt**, died in June, 2010.

We already miss every one of these people who played instrumental roles in the history of Kapaun and of Kapaun Mt. Carmel. It was my privilege to have known them personally.

Words cannot express the excitement that was in the air throughout the evening. It was truly a gathering of people who have a love of Kapaun Mt. Carmel Catholic High School – even after many decades have passed in the case of some of the guests.

Congratulations to all of the new and existing members of the KMC Hall of Fame. You are inspirations to everyone in the Kapaun Mt. Carmel community.

Annual Fund

The 2010-11 Annual Fund continues, as we march toward our goal of \$300,000 by June 30, 2011. So far, more than \$170,000 has been given by the KMC community, including 233 gifts from our 7,800 alumni. There are currently pledges outstanding totaling \$21,000.

Many of you were called recently in our fall Phonathon by members of the KMC student body. The fall Phonathon, which ran for seven nights, drew a record 261 total volunteers, all of whom made calls to members of the KMC community. Thank you to those who were contacted for giving our volunteer students your attention and for considering a gift to the Annual Fund this year.

Even with the record number of callers, it was impossible to reach most of you by phone during the seven nights of the Phonathon. We do need your help! I would ask three things of our alumni:

Alumni Memorial Endowment

Alumni of Kapaun Mt. Carmel Catholic High School, Mount Carmel Academy, and especially those of Chaplain Kapaun Memorial High School have been provided a special way to “give back” to KMC.

Under the leadership of Jerry Riedl '59, a special endowment fund has been created. The Chaplain Kapaun Jesuit High School Alumni Memorial Endowment was created to assist those parents who are financially stressed with the payment of the annual enrollment fees for their students who attend KMC. These fees total more than \$600 per year for each student enrolled.

Why establish this endowment?

“The years at Chaplain Kapaun Memorial changed my life,” said Riedl. “With the help of the Jesuits and the environment at Kapaun, I developed two things in high school that I otherwise would not have had.”

“I developed a love for learning at Kapaun that I am sure could not be duplicated anywhere else. More importantly, with the help of the Jesuits, I developed a deepened love for Jesus Christ.”

“I want to give something back to the

school that has done much for me. I believe that much is expected from those to whom much has been given.”

Jerry has enlisted the help of alumni from several class years to begin the process of contacting classmates and asking them to participate financially in the endowment fund. Among those assisting him so far are Jerry Aaron '58, Ron Hund '60 and Fr. Michael Harter, S.J., '61.
