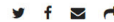

Record crowd packs Riverfront Stadium for Carroll-Kapaun high school football game

More than 8,600 fans were at Riverfront Stadium for a record-setting crowd to watch the Bishop Carroll football team defeat Kapaun Mt. Carmel 26-21 on Friday. JEREMY DAVIS/Courtesy

A record-setting crowd was in attendance for the first high school football game played at Riverfront Stadium, as Bishop Carroll prevailed with a 26-21 win over Kapaun Mt. Carmel on Friday.

A total of 8,066 fans came out to watch the Catholic rivalry game in Wichita's new downtown baseball stadium, which was transformed into a football field by the groundskeeping crew of the Wichita Wind Surge.

The crowd topped the previous record that was set earlier this summer when 7,709 fans witnessed the first no-hitter in Wind Surge history on Aug. 20, 2022 and the 7,509 fans who came for the stadium's debut for a Wichita State baseball game on April 10, 2021.

Riverfront Stadium, home of the Wind Surge baseball team, hosted the 60th anniversary of the “Holy War,” the epic rivalry between Kapaun Mt. Carmel and Bishop Carroll. The game was one of many local rivalries Riverfront is hosting in the next few years. The Eagles vs. the Crusaders matchup Oct. 7 boasted the venue’s largest crowd to date with more than 8,000 spectators. Carroll won the contest 26-21, continuing its winning streak that began in 2000. Next season’s game featuring Wichita’s two Catholic schools will also be at Riverfront, with KMC acting as host and home team.

“That was an awesome experience that I think the kids on both teams are going to talk about for the rest of their lives,” said Carroll coach Dusty Trail, in an Oct. 8 Varsity Kansas article. “Shoot, that was something special for me and I’ve been coaching high school football (for three-plus decades). It was a pretty cool night.”

Opening the Soul to the Sense of the Eternal

Recently, I was privileged to attend the memorial Mass for Eleanor Malone, a beloved member of the KMC community. The Mass was beautiful, punctuated by the recounting of Eleanor’s many contributions, particularly at her home parish, the Church of the Magdalen. Eleanor’s creativity and dedication to beauty have been woven into the fabric of Magdalen for decades. Eleanor and her late husband, Cliff, had eight children and were heavily involved in Catholic education. Two of their sons graduated from Chaplain Kapaun Memorial, and two Malone children graduated from Kapaun Mt. Carmel.

During the late 1990s and early 2000s, I served on the Magdalen building committee with Eleanor, as we moved our parish from Kellogg and Woodlawn to its new location on the corner of 127th Street East and 21st Street North. The moving of a parish and the design and construction of its church, school, and supporting spaces were monumental tasks, and our committee met weekly or bi-weekly for several years.

In those meetings, we had massive decisions to make, which spawned lengthy discussions about the engineering propriety of shapes of buildings, placement of liturgical furnishings, fit, finish, materials, and other matters; real “heady” stuff, in my opinion. But, Eleanor’s focus was more refined than that. Many times in those meetings, Eleanor would stop us and ask the simplest of questions about when, how and where the beauty of liturgical art would be perceived by the faithful. What colors would be seen? When would the light catch this or that part of the sanctuary? The tiniest of detail about color, art, and beauty would be questioned by Eleanor.

Stay with me on this, but Eleanor’s questions and challenges often drove me crazy because, in my truly naïve state-of-mind, we had big-picture things to worry about. Details could come later. But Eleanor remained faithful to the details, because in her experience, and with years of personal and communal perception of our parish, she knew these details mattered from the very beginning of design.

Eleanor had good company in this regard. At the same time that she was challenging us with her dedication to the beauty of art in the worship space, then Pope, now St. John Paul II, wrote his famous Letter to Artists, where he said that works of art focused on the Creator, “affirm that true beauty which, as a glimmer of the Spirit of God, will transfigure matter, opening the human soul to the sense of the eternal.”

All these thoughts came flooding back to me the second I woke up on the day of Eleanor’s memorial Mass. It was as if she were reaching out to me in her transition to the eternal. I immediately thought about our own chapel here at Kapaun Mt. Carmel, which we are expanding and remodeling as a part of our Spirit and Strength Capital Campaign. Here I am, some 20 plus years later, helping to design another worship environment, worried about structure, placement, ceiling height and other matters. That morning, Eleanor’s presence brought me not to frustration, but rather, to peace. I realized with great clarity that she had been right all along. God’s presence, as Eleanor knew, is manifested in beauty, and the beauty of art and environment in the worship space is paramount to the human experience. It is precisely what both Eleanor and St. John Paul II meant back in the 1990s.

Ever since that day when Eleanor’s words came back to me, these thoughts have influenced the design of our chapel tremendously. We have decided that works of art will take on a prominent role in the final design of the chapel. Our goal through this art will be to open the souls of our students to the sense of the eternal every time they enter our chapel for prayer, adoration and worship. We have already begun to discuss this with very accomplished artists, who share our vision and are excited to be involved in our project. I look forward to sharing with you the final design over the coming months and, of course, invite you to participate in our Spirit and Strength Capital Campaign, and to visit our newly expanded and refurbished chapel upon its completion in the summer of 2023.

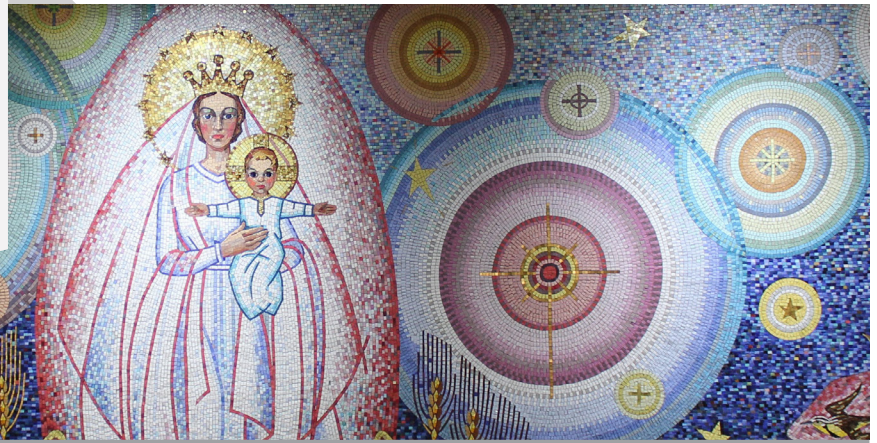
Eleanor, I finally get it. Thank you for teaching me. May you rest in the eternal peace of Christ.

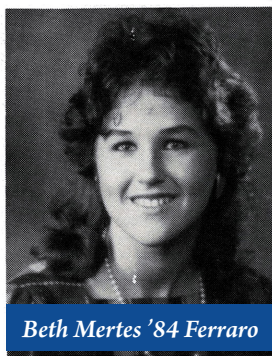

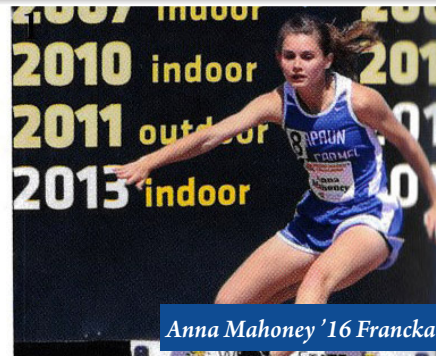
