

On Friday, October 20th during our Inservice Day, SAGES' teachers applied the "Walls are Optional" motto and took it on the road! With the help of Beth Schaefer from Wisconsin AG in the Classroom, SAGES Teachers were able to visit Graves Family Orchard, an organic orchard located on HWY 49 in Brownsville.







Tyler, the proprietor of the orchard, was able to share with us how he and his family take care of the orchard. We learned how apple trees often start with the grafting process; and how his organic orchard is different than a "traditionally" run orchard. Then, SAGES teachers traveled to the Horicon Marsh to hear about the history of the marsh, and how easily we can incorporate the world around us and agriculture into our science and social studies lessons.

There will be slots available at the Beaver Dam YMCA on Wednesday, October 25th from 3 pm-5 pm. Parents should utilize their well-child visits for this purpose if they are insured and have a primary care physician established. If your child has seen a provider for a well-child visit within the last 12 months, they can call that provider and have the sports physical signed and back-dated to that last visit. The clinic is trying to keep these slots open for those students and families who are uninsured. This is a free service being donated by Marshfield Medical Center - Beaver Dam.
