


The Proposed Budget

Projected Tax Levy Impact


Maximum Allowable Tax Levy increase with 50% + 1 Vote:





 - Proposed Expenditure: \$1,120,000







Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure (Prop #2) MHS Drop Ceiling Replacement


