
2022-23 Tax Levy Information

District's **Proposed** 2022-2023 Tax Levy increase: 1.99% increase




The District is proposing to increase the 2022-23 tax levy by less than the allowable amount as per the Tax Cap Levy formula

How is the 2022-2023 budget spent?



Three Part Budget

Proposed budget for the 2022-2023 school year is \$64,407,654



Budget includes all instructional components, as well as administrative and capital costs.










Capital Outlay Project
