


The Proposed Budget

Maximum <u>Allowable</u> Tax Levy increase with 50% + 1 Vote:


1.53% increase

State Aid Update

The 2021/22 State Legislative budget established 2021/22 State aid figures

- The District received just over \$1 million of additional State aid funding. These funds will be allocated for the following:
 - To eliminate the budget gap
 - To address necessary roof repairs at MHS
 - To maintain class sizes with expanding enrollment at DAV & MWD
 - To address Special Education Tuition increases
 - To address K-5 transportation increases


The District will be committing over \$1.8M as additional revenue:





May 2021 Propositions

- 1. <u>Prop #1:</u> 2021-22 Budget/Tax Levy
 - Proposed Budget: \$61,957,097
 - Proposed Tax Levy: \$45,922,615

2. Prop #2: Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure



- Prop #3: Seeking to change the election of Board of Education members from "designated" to "at large"
 - As of the 2022 election voting shall be "at large", rather than for specific vacancies

Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure (Prop #2)

- These expenditures will be at NO ADDITIONAL COST to taxpayers
- Proposition to authorize the expenditure of \$2,080,000
- The following projects are being proposed:
 - MHS Varsity Baseball Field Upgrade
 - District-wide site improvements

What happens if the proposed budget is not approved on May 18th?




The district may do one of the following:
