
2021-22 Tax Levy Information

District's **Proposed** 2021-2022 Tax Levy increase: 1.52% increase




The District is proposing to increase the 2021-22 tax levy by less than the allowable amount as per the Tax Cap Levy formula

Three Part Budget

Proposed budget for the 2021-2022 school year is \$61,957,097



Budget includes all instructional components, as well as administrative and capital costs.



Expenditure budget is a map of a spending plan. Parts within the budget are ever moving based on the current needs of the programs and students.

What happens if the proposed budget is not approved on May 18th?



The district may do one of the following:

- Resubmit the defeated budget to the voters on June 15, 2021
- Submit a revised budget to the voters on June 15, 2021
- Adopt a contingent budget

May 2021 Propositions

- 1. <u>Prop #1:</u> 2021-22 Budget/Tax Levy
 - Proposed Budget: \$61,957,097
 - Proposed Tax Levy: \$45,922,615

2. Prop #2: Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure



- Prop #3: Seeking to change the election of Board of Education members from "designated" to "at large"
 - As of the 2022 election voting shall be "at large", rather than for specific vacancies

Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure (Prop #2)

- These expenditures will be at NO ADDITIONAL COST to taxpayers
- Proposition to authorize the expenditure of \$2,080,000
- The following projects are being proposed:
 - MHS Varsity Baseball Field Upgrade
 - District-wide site improvements
