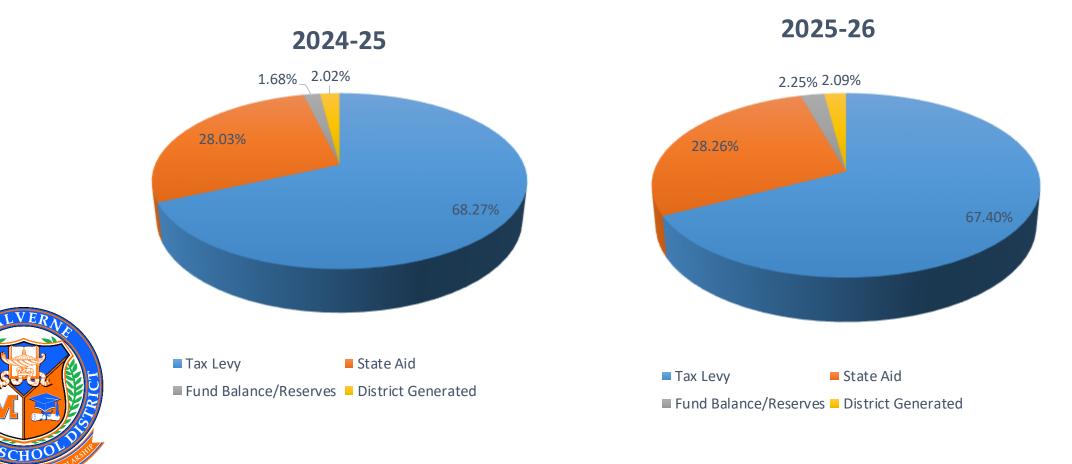

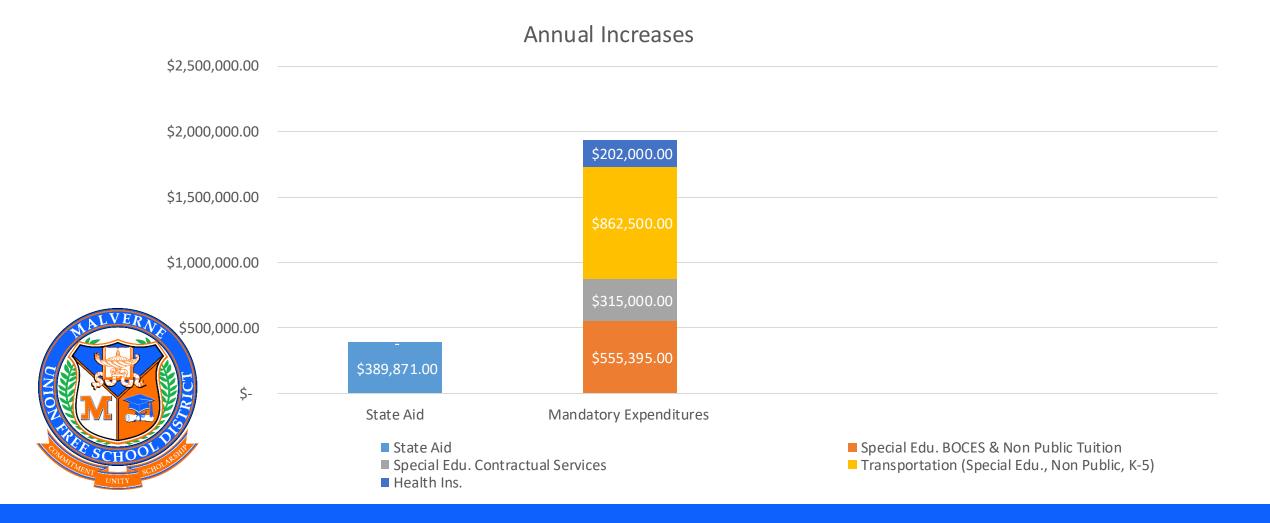

Projected Tax Levy Impact

Maximum <u>Allowable</u> Tax Levy increase with 50% + 1 Vote: 2.44% increase

District's initial **Proposed** 2025-2026 Tax Levy increase: **2.44% increase**



The District is proposing to increase the 2025-26 tax levy by the allowable amount as per the Tax Cap Levy formula

Fund Balance & Reserves

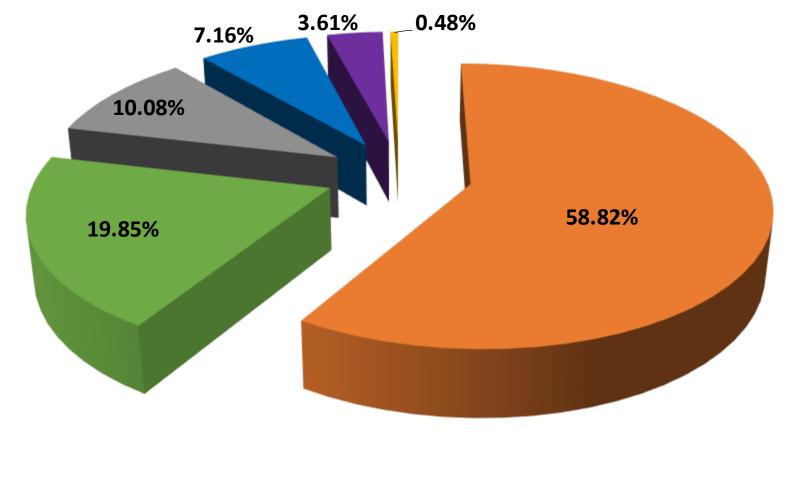
The District has continued its commitment to the return of over \$1.6M to the Taxpayers from the budget/reserves to reduce taxes and maintain budget expenditures.

Supplemented reserves to assist with Insurance, Debt Service, Teacher Retirement System Contributions, Employees Retirement System Contributions, etc.



Maintained reserve levels to provide cash flow and address large, unexpected changes in expense or revenue projections.

May 2025 Propositions

- 1. <u>Prop #1:</u> 2025-26 Budget/Tax Levy
 - Proposed Budget: \$73,956,825
 - Proposed Tax Levy: \$49,848,836



- 2. <u>Prop #2:</u> Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure
 - Proposed Expenditure: \$1,350,000

Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure (Prop #2)

- These expenditures will be at NO ADDITIONAL COST
- Proposition to authorize the expenditure of \$1,350,000
- The following projects are being proposed:
 - MHS Multi-Field Scoreboard
 - DAV & MWD Playground Upgrades
 - MHS Window Replacements
 - Districtwide Promethean Board (Equipment) Replacements
 - Districtwide Door Upgrades



What happens if the proposed budget is not approved on May 20th?



The district may do one of the following:



- Resubmit the defeated budget to the voters on June 17, 2025
- Submit a revised budget to the voters on June 17, 2025
- Adopt a contingent budget
