Projected Tax Levy Impact

Maximum Allowable Tax Levy increase with 50% + 1 Vote: 2.44% increase

District's **Proposed** 2025-2026 Tax Levy increase: **2.44% increase**



The District is proposing to increase the 2025-26 tax levy by the allowable amount as per the Tax Cap Levy formula






Capital Outlay Project
