MARCH - APRIL

- Submit/update FAFSA
- Celebrate your acceptances. Let your counselor and recommenders know of your acceptances, so they can celebrate with you!
- Review financial aid award letters from the colleges you have been accepted to

- Complete the enrollment process at the college or trade school you will be attending.
- Send an email to the colleges that you will not be attending to let them know of your plans

MAY - JULY

Decision Day - May 1

- Continue to check your college portal for information regarding class registration, new student orientation, and move-in information
- Request your FINAL AHS transcript to be sent through Parchment (Request before July 1)
- Request your FINAL Dual Credit transcript to be sent through the Dual Credit provider
