Interior/Exterior Site Improvements

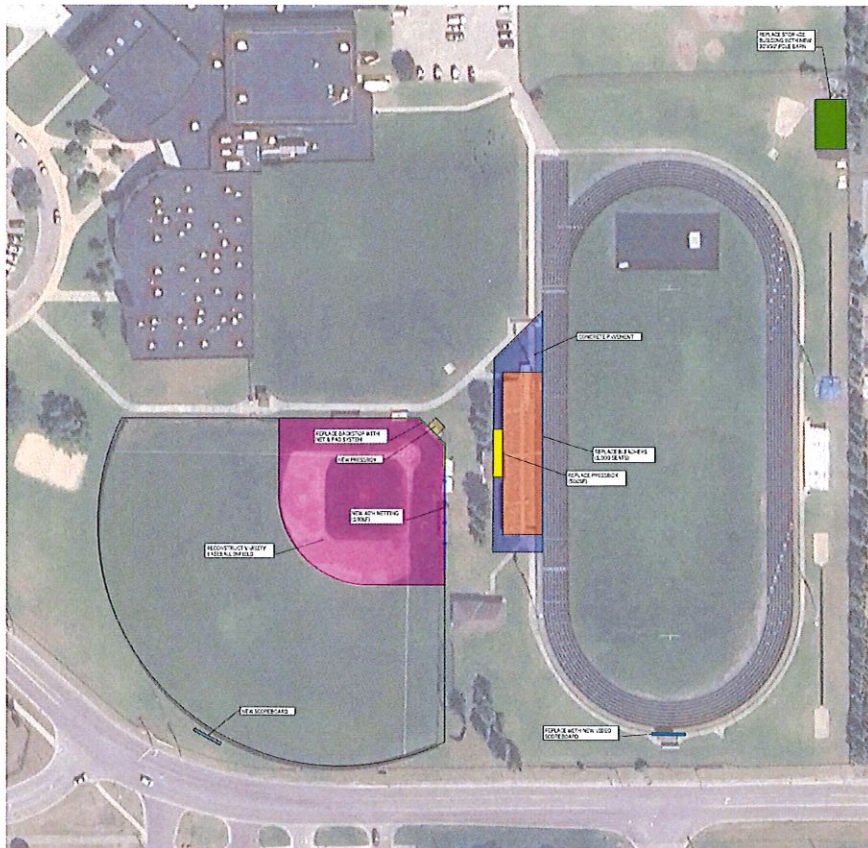
Like the middle school, this building had extensive updates from the May 2020 bond, so the work here is limited. This building hosts our alternative high school program called Morgan Shaw School, serving 30-40 students per year. It also hosts *Early Learners*, our very popular and growing preschool program. BCPS has 140 preschool students aged 3 and 4, with 8 classrooms.

Bond proposal projects include renovation of the Morgan Shaw bathrooms and converting the current culinary kitchen into a production kitchen for our Food Service program to cook on site. Currently, we have to cook all the food for this building at the HS and shuttle it downtown, which is not very efficient.

What bond projects are included at the Athletic Complex?

Interior/Exterior Site Improvements

Since the community came together in 1996 to famously “turn the football field” and create the space for the baseball field, this space has served the Rambler athletic community very well. 27 years later, we need to replace and renovate a few elements of the fields. Earl Brotherson Field would have new bleachers, a new press box, and LED lighting. The playing fields would remain grass but get improvements needed from naturally occurring issues with fields that have happened over 27 years.
