

## Edward Reynolds- Mayor City of Bainbridge

Edward Reynolds was sworn in as Mayor of the City of Bainbridge January 7, 2010, 5 years after his father, Bill Reynolds, retired as Bainbridge's Mayor. Bill served the City of Bainbridge from 1978 to 2005.

Edward is a 1982 graduate of Bainbridge High School and went on to graduate from Auburn University Harrison School of Pharmacy. He is the owner of Bainbridge Pharmacy, a drug store his family has owned since 1959. He began working there for his father in 1989.

Mayor Reynolds is a servant leader, a person who selflessly places service to others in our local community as well as Southwest Georgia. He operates several successful businesses in the area and was elected by his peers to serve two terms as Chairman of the Bainbridge – Decatur County Chamber of Commerce. Mayor Reynolds has also been involved at the state and regional level serving on the Georgia Municipal Association Board of Directors and on the Leadership Georgia Board of Directors.

In his role as Mayor, Edward has been instrumental in the complete renovation of our historic City Hall as well as the Chason Park Expansion Project, set for completion in 2023. Mayor Reynolds has played a key role in the major upgrade of our Water Pollution Control Plant and our Fiber to the Home Project which is set to begin construction in Spring 2023.
