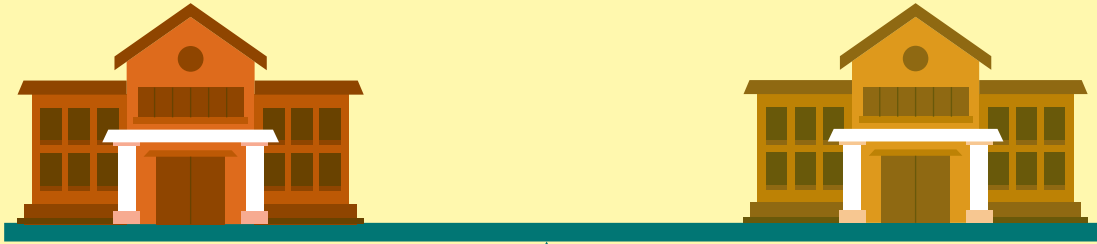

# Phase 2 Redistricting

Superintendent's Recommendation

In accordance with Board of Education Policy JAA, Redistricting and Attendance Areas, this document contains the Superintendent's Recommendations on Phase 2 Redistricting (South). The Superintendent's Recommendations have been informed by the presentation of Scenarios 1, 2, and 3, which were developed by consultant WXY, as well as by the integration of public comments gathered through community engagement and internal review processes.

The Superintendent is offering two recommendations for the Board of Education's consideration. Both recommendations, which are detailed in this report, take into consideration feedback from the webtool and community engagement sessions. The following notable adjustments are made to current school boundaries as part of the Superintendent's Recommendations:

- **Boundary adjustments:**

- *Recommendation 1*

- Elementary school boundaries in the Arundel and Meade clusters are changed to address new and upcoming housing developments in Two Rivers and Odenton Town Center.
    - Elementary school boundaries for the Glen Isle and Hambleton neighborhoods in Riva are revised, resulting in the reassignment of students from Davidsonville Elementary School to Central Elementary School.
    - To relieve overcrowding, the middle school and high school boundaries for the Arundel, Crofton, and Meade clusters are being adjusted.
    - The boundary between Annapolis and South River high schools will change. To reduce future overcrowding, high school students in the Walter S. Mills-Parole Elementary School attendance area will attend South River High School.

- *Recommendation 2*

- Elementary school boundaries in the Arundel and Meade clusters are changed to address new and upcoming housing developments in Two Rivers and Odenton Town Center.
    - Elementary school boundaries for the Glen Isle and Hambleton neighborhoods in Riva are revised, resulting in the reassignment of students from Davidsonville Elementary School to Central Elementary School.
    - To relieve overcrowding, the middle school and high school boundaries for the Arundel, Crofton and Meade clusters are being adjusted.

- **Programmatic Realignment**

- *Recommendation 1*

- No programmatic realignments are recommended.

- *Recommendation 2*

- The portion of the Apex Arts program currently housed at Annapolis High School will be moved to a new location.

- **Articulation Adjustments**

- *Recommendation 1*

- A portion of the middle and high school students living in the Nantucket Elementary School attendance area are reassigned to Arundel Middle School and Arundel High School.
    - High school students living in the Walter S. Mills-Parole Elementary School attendance area are reassigned to South River High School.

- *Recommendation 2*

- A portion of the middle and high school students living in the Nantucket Elementary School attendance area are reassigned to Arundel Middle School and Arundel High School.

Approximately 1,500 students are rezoned in Superintendent’s Recommendation 1 and 1,100 students are rezoned in Superintendent’s Recommendation 2.

Both recommendations utilize the existing capacity to improve the utilization of schools throughout the county. Subject to the approval of an updated State Rated Capacity (SRC) for Crofton High School, all schools included in the study are projected to operate at under 100 percent utilization following full implementation of either recommendation.

Both Superintendent’s Recommendations also contain the same “Legacy Student” provision that existed in Phase 1 of the redistricting process. Students who will be entering 12th grade in the 2026-2027 school year will have the option to remain at the high school to which they are currently assigned. Students electing to remain at their current high school will be required to enter a Legacy Student transfer portal to indicate that choice and must provide their own transportation to and from school.





Current magnet program assignments will be honored. In Superintendent’s Recommendation 1, students currently enrolled in a magnet program at a secondary school will continue to be enrolled in their current assigned program and school. In Superintendent’s Recommendation 2, students enrolled in a magnet program at a secondary school (excluding Apex Arts at Annapolis High School) will remain at their current schools. The portion of the Apex Arts program currently housed at Annapolis High School will be moved to a new location. Transportation for magnet students will continue to be provided.

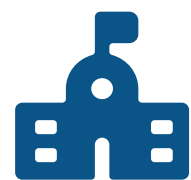

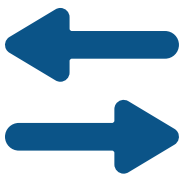

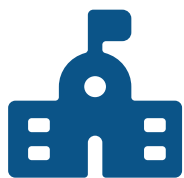

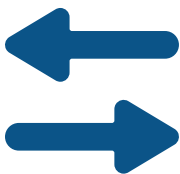

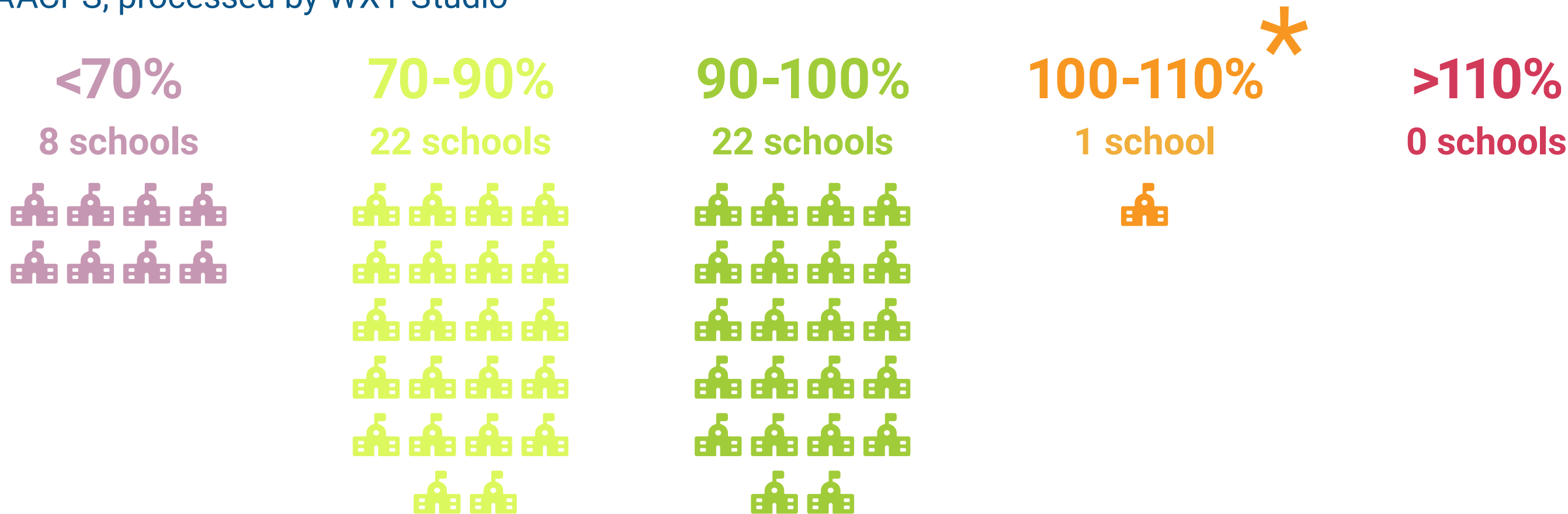

Estimated utilizations if no boundary changes are implemented (SY2024-25 Enrollment)

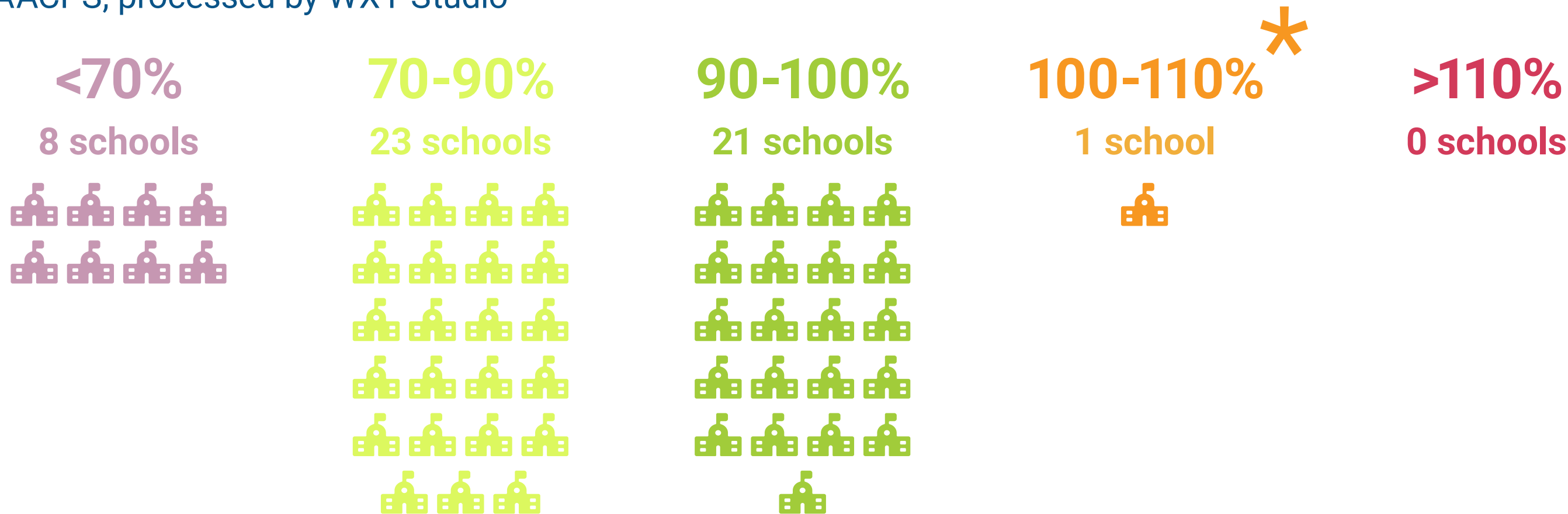

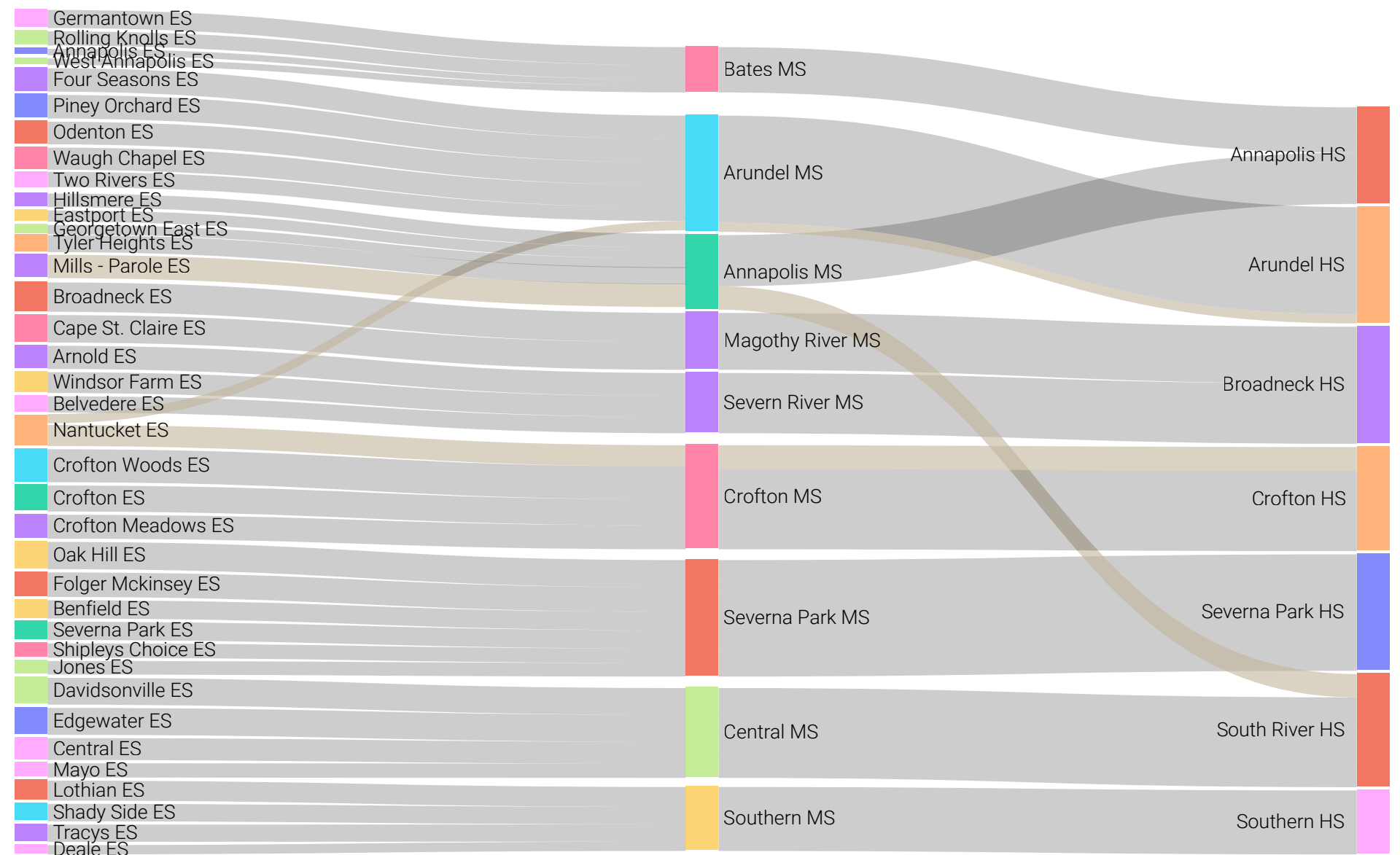

## Superintendent Recommendation 1: Feeder Patterns

- HS students living in the Mills-Parole ES zone are rezoned to South River HS.



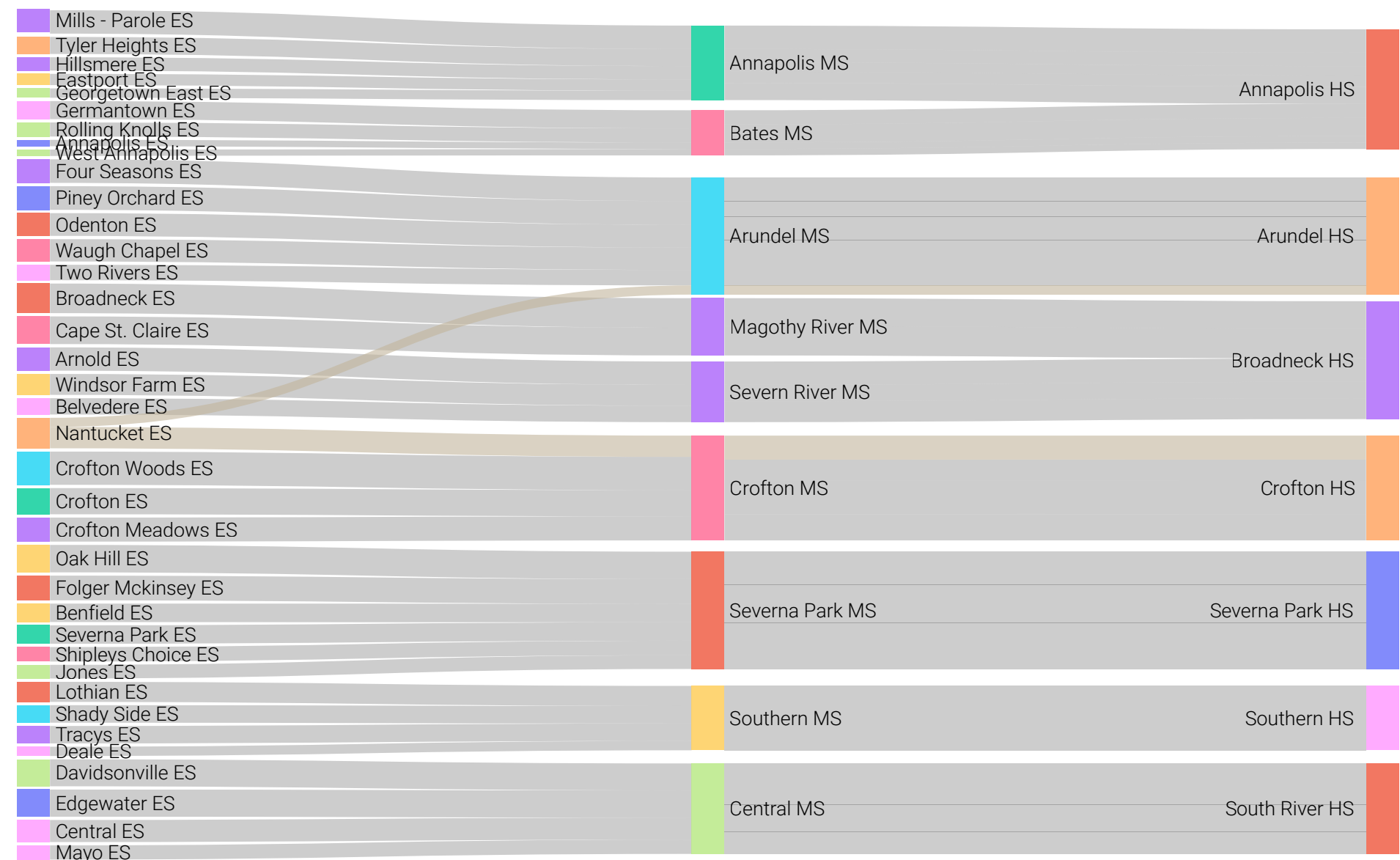
