



## Salisbury High School Dual Enrollment Program

### REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

To register for a dual enrollment course, all students **MUST** follow these procedures:

- 1) Visit <a href="https://www.shu.edu/project-acceleration/index.cfm">https://www.shu.edu/project-acceleration/index.cfm</a>, to complete the "Project Acceleration Information Update" form. As per Seton Hall University, this form will be accessible from January 3rd to March 1st at 11:59PM.
- 2) Once this form has been submitted, students/parents/guardians will receive an email from SHU. The subject line will read "Thank you for your interest in Project Acceleration." This email will confirm that SHU has secured the student's contact information in their system.
- 3) PAYMENT IS ONLINE ONLY. Students will receive a detailed payment email from SHU in 3-5 business days after completing the initial "Project Acceleration Information Update" form. This email will include the student's SHU student ID. and the link for making payment. Please keep an eye on your spam folder. If you do not receive this communication, please email projectacceleration@shu.edu with the student's full name and high school and SHU will resend the payment information promptly.
  - a. If SHU does not have payment by the set deadline, students will not receive dual enrollment credit. SHU will not accept any payments made after March 11th at 11:59pm. Any payment made on March 12th will be refunded.
  - b. **PRICE INCREASE:** The cost of one credit is \$110. Therefore, a 3-credit course will cost \$330 and a 4-credit course will cost \$440.
- 4) **NEW!!** Students will no longer receive an email from SHU with an attached registration form, as in years past. Now, SHU will consider a student's payment through the SHU online portal the only form of documented registration.
- 5) ONCE THE PAYMENT EMAIL FROM SHU IS RECEIVED, IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT IT IS FORWARDED TO MRS. MOYER (AMOYER@SALISBURYSD.ORG) OR PRINTED AND SUBMITTED TO THE SCHOOL COUNSELING OFFICE FOR RECORD KEEPING PURPOSES.

- Students may earn no more than **22** Seton Hall credits during their SHS academic career.
- Students must earn a **C** or better to earn Seton Hall University credit.
- Please note, it is the discretion of the post-secondary institution you plan to attend to determine if Seton Hall University credits will be accepted. Neither Seton Hall University nor Salisbury Township School District will be responsible if credits earned are not transferable.
