## **How to Be an Eagle Fan**

All students should comply with the following guidelines when attending school activities for events:

- Exhibit good sportsmanship: respecting our fans, other fans, referees, coaches, our team, their team, etc.
- Sit in the bleachers or stands and watch the game/event.
- Be respectful of others attending the game/event.
- Show school spirit by cheering for the Eagle teams.
- Be on your best behavior and model good conduct for others at all times.
- Comply with behavior expectations and directives given by staff members.
- Dress appropriately for the event, preferably wearing Eagle Spirit attire.
- Take care of Eagle Stadium, the Summit, and other school facilities throw trash away, clean up after yourself, etc.

## **Conduct Before and After School**

Teachers and administrators have full authority over student conduct at, before, or after-school activities on district premises and at any school-sponsored event regardless of location. Students are subject to the same rules of conduct that apply during the instructional day and will be subject to consequences established by the student Code of Conduct.

Unless participating in an organized school activity (tutorial, club meeting, athletic or academic practice or competition, etc.) students should not be on campus before 7:15am and should leave school premises upon dismissal for the day.

All students attending school athletic or extra-curricular activities or events as spectators are expected to report directly to the appropriate facility, sit in the bleachers/stands, watch the game or event, and support the Eagle teams. A student section has been designated for athletic events. Students in grades 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> are encouraged to sit in the designated student sections but may certainly choose to sit with parents instead.

Elementary and Intermediate students (PreK-5), including children not yet in school, must be accompanied and monitored by an adult at all extra-curricular events. They should be seated with the parents/guardians as the student sections are for students in 6<sup>th</sup> grade and up only. Children under 6<sup>th</sup> grade should never be dropped off and left alone without parental supervision. Older siblings who are still in school are not considered adults for supervision purposes.

Prohibited behaviors include but are not limited to: running around the grounds or facilities; playing games; hanging around in groups by the entrances, concession stands, restrooms, under the bleachers, or other areas of the school; being generally disruptive or disrespectful; or refusing to comply with staff directives.

Students may certainly go to the concession stands and restrooms; however, they are to walk, use proper conduct and courtesy, go directly to these areas and then return directly to their seats. Elementary aged students or younger should be accompanied by an adult.
