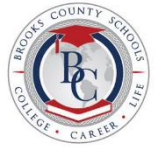

## Our 2023-2024 Goals for Student Achievement

### District Goal:

- Brooks County School District will increase the percentage of students scoring Developing or higher by 3% as measured by the Spring 24 End of Grade and End of Course Georgia Milestones Assessment System.
- Brooks County School District will improve areas of the climate rating by 3% through the implementation of targeted resources and interventions.

### School Goals:

- Using the HMH Growth Measure Beginning of Year scores as a baseline, 80% of DIS students will increase their reading proficiency during the 2023-2024 school year as measured by the HMH Growth Measure End of Year scores.
- During the 2023 – 2024 school year, Delta Innovative School will decrease the number of students missing more than 10% of their enrolled days.
- During the 2023 - 2024 school year, we will maintain a minimum graduation rate of 80%.
