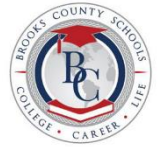

Our 2023-2024 Goals for Student Achievement

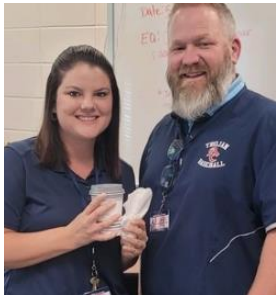
District Goal:
