July 2025 Desk/ Transportation Audit

The following agencies are scheduled to participate:

- Bus Safety Inspector – our inspection will include brake stops
- Motor Carrier Investigators (MCI)
- DMV BDU



Bus Safety inspectors will complete

- Fleet inspections on all vehicles including brake stops.
- Short term the replacement certificates to have the same expiration date as original prior inspection.
- Requires garage personnel to be present to be able to operate bus lifts and operate vehicle for road test and brake stops.



MCI staff will review: Drug and Alcohol Testing Information

- Driver List (past 365 days) – example attached.
- Pre-employment drug tests for anyone hired within the last 365 days.
- Reasonable Suspicion Testing proof (Managers).
- List of drivers currently enrolled in random drug and alcohol testing (usually provided by testing consortium).
- Proof of Lansing CSD enrollment with drug and alcohol testing consortium.
- Summary of 2024 drug and alcohol testing rates (usually provided by testing consortium).
- Any failed or refusal testing results of drivers requiring testing.
- Drug and alcohol policy.
- Proof drivers have received drug and alcohol testing materials.



Required Maintenance Files

- Vehicle list – example attached.
- Files of all vehicles with PM history, brake pulls, and any other work performed (previous 2 years).
- DVIR's for all vehicles for previous 6 months.

- 19-A Roster of Active Drivers
- Lansing CSD Driver Roster and Documents Requested spreadsheet
