With upcoming pauses to SNAP payments, we understand that many families may be feeling uncertain about how to access healthy food.

Food security is vital for student success, and EdAdvance Food Services is here to offer any support we can during this difficult time.

Below are some important things for you to know:

First, students who qualify for Free or Reduced meals due to SNAP benefits, Husky A qualifications or through Meal Applications will continue to receive their free or reduced meals at school.

Second, if you are experiencing even **temporary changes** in your family income at any time throughout the year **you may apply for Free or Reduced School Meals through the Application on your school food service web page.**
