SCHOOL BUSINESS

Administration- cell phone policy update - students give it a thumbs down, but support the reasoning. First 6 days in January had overall 2.12% of students violating the policy, first 6 days in February is .82% of students. Students are more respectful, polite, and engaged. Parents are supportive when contacted about a violation.

Incentive plan discussed and decided - the grade with the lowest percent of violations at the end of each week will have a drawing for gift cards. Students who did violate cannot win, and a student can only win once. This will not be communicated to parents so that students focus on the intrinsic reward. PTSA gifted money to the school to support this plan through the remainder of the school year.

Parent Teacher Conferences - faculty really likes having the dinner break at 5:00, parents are supportive of this. Discussed benefits of full virtual vs fully in-person vs a hybrid. Possibility next school year of doing 1.5 days in first and third terms, and let second term be for 6th grade orientation night with all faculty.

Counseling - elementary visits and orientation this week, new student orientation Feb 21 5:30-7:30 in 2 sessions. PTSA is invited to speak briefly at each session and have a booth to onboard new parents. Some students will be in the blue representing clubs, other groups will just have the advisor. Packets going to 6th graders on Feb 22 and 23, and parents will receive an email about the packet.

Lots of parent involvement in 9th grade CCRs, 8th starting soon, 7th graders have their class request sheet- it is due this Friday.

VHS tour was great. Beneficial for CJH students and VHS as a whole.

Purple Week in April - Kim Wirfs and Mr. Griffiths are working on a week for this. Follow up in March.
