Intended Outcomes:

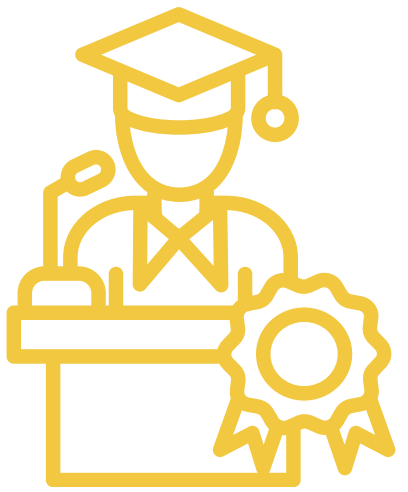
- to set the context and goals for two key leadership positions.

Safety and Belonging

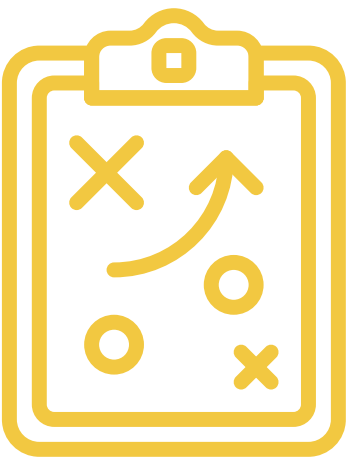
- **Fostering collective safety and security**
