In June of 2022, she became our angel dancing in the sky. Caitlyn truly loved the Campbellsport Dance Program and all of the people associated with it. She wanted the best for all of her little dancers, both on the performance floor and in life.

Scholarship Requirements

- *This scholarship is only available to a graduating senior from CHS that went through the dance program and that Caitlyn coached at one time (2019-2022)
- *Completed application forms must be submitted, by mail or in person, to the counseling office by April 5, 2024 by noon
- *Copy of most recent high school transcript, must request by counseling office
- *Submit a list of school and community activities. Include awards, honors, years of participation, and leadership roles
- *Picture of yourself
- *Submit a typed letter reflecting on your relationship with Caitlyn Ziegelbauer, how she influenced your life, and how she inspired you to be a better dancer and a better person

This \$300 scholarship will be paid upon the scholarship recipient providing verification of completion of their first semester in a two year associate degree program or a bachelor's degree, with grades showing proof of completion with passing grades in all classes.
