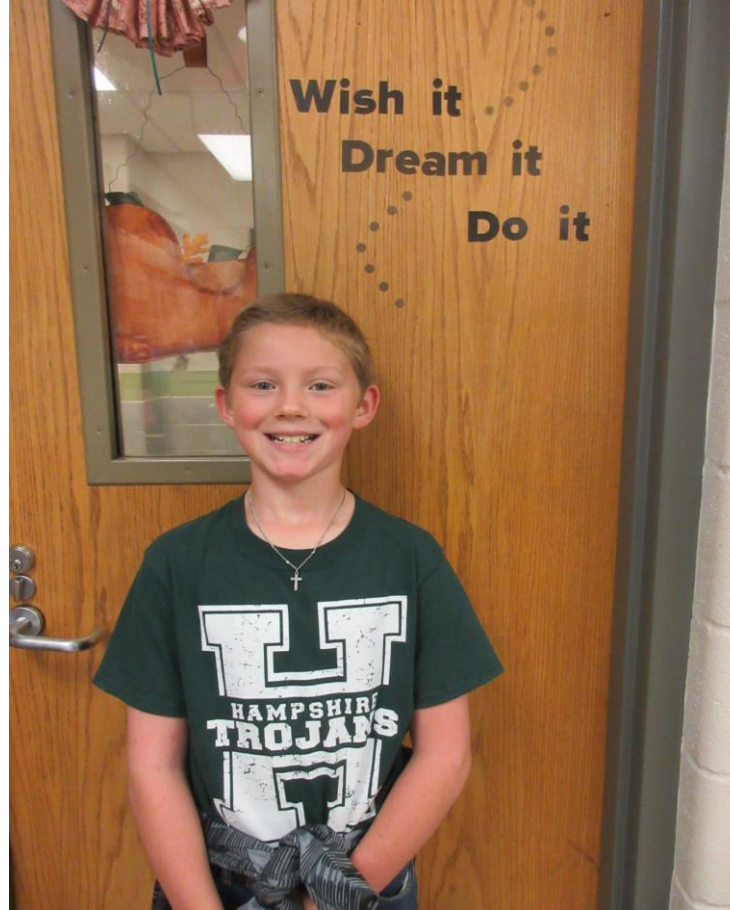
Natalie Braithwaite- 7th Grade Capon Bridge Middle School
