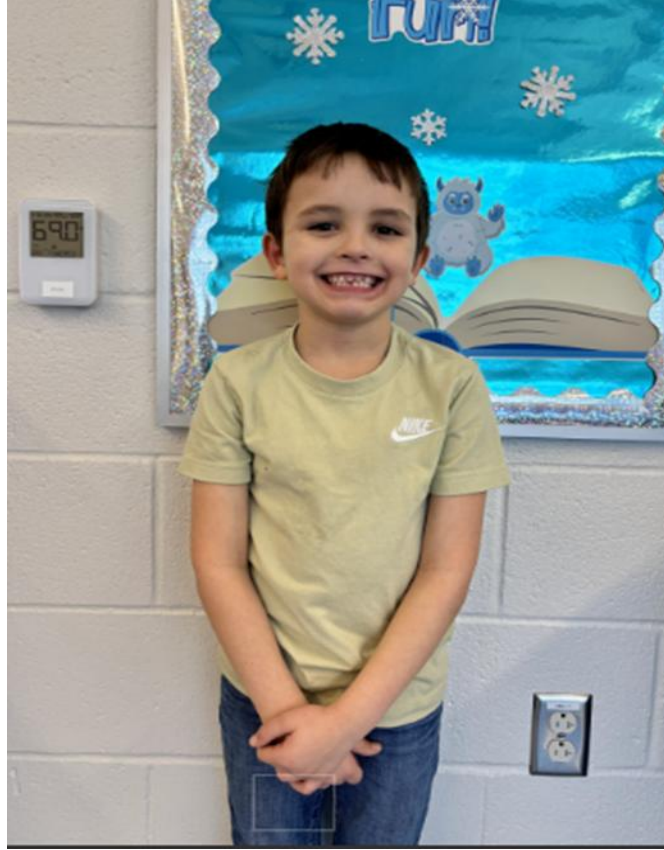
## Lucian Doughty - Capon Bridge Elementary

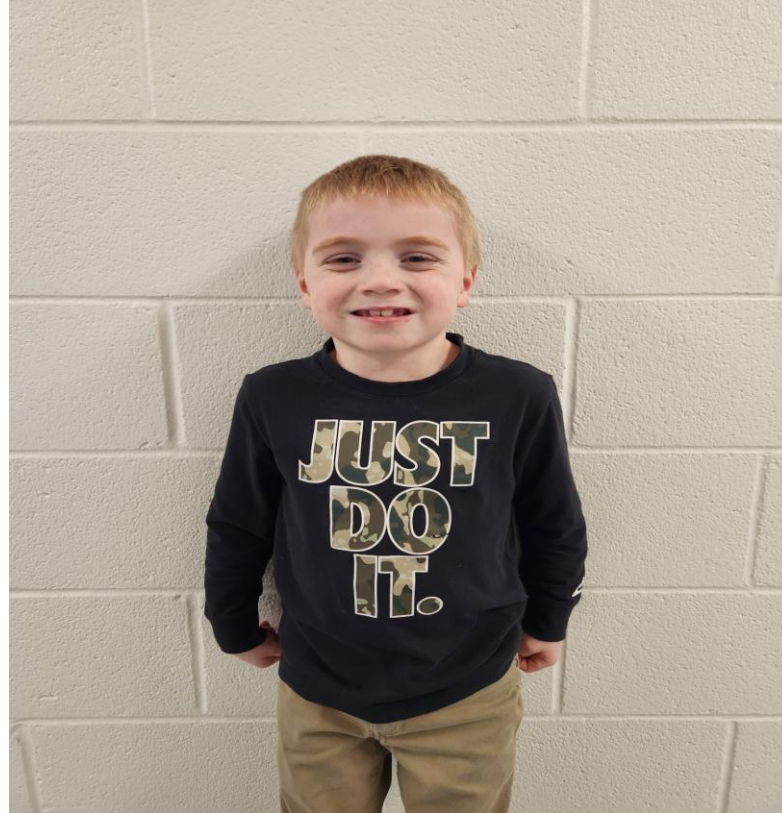
## Layken Caldwell - Ice Mountain Elementary School

## Alanna Valle - South Branch Elementary

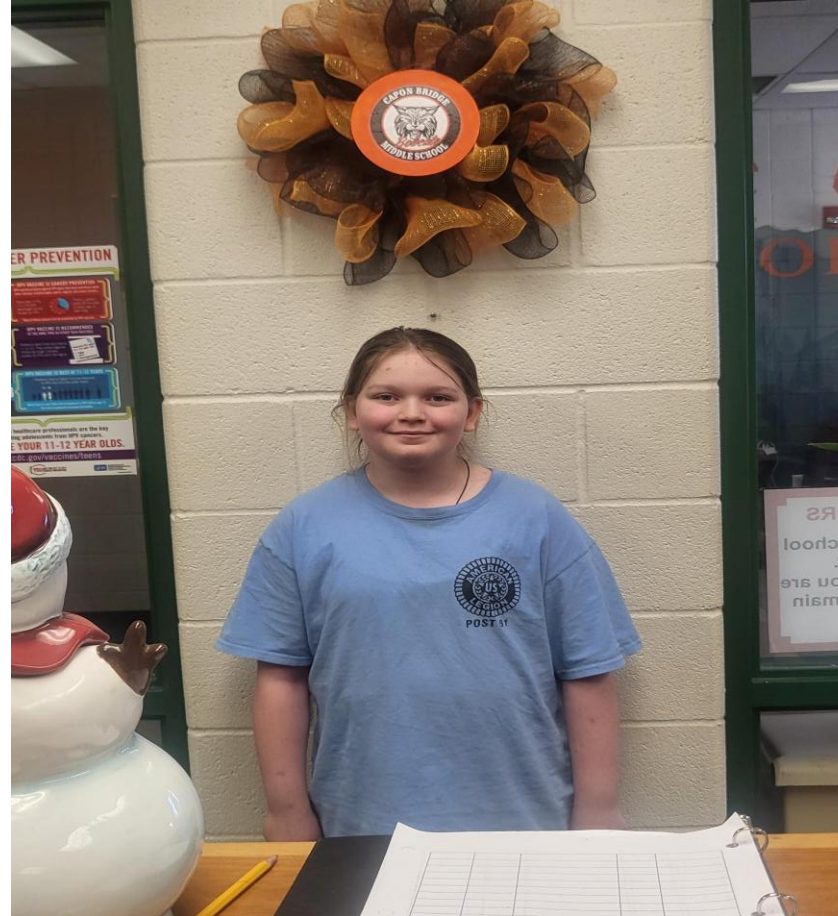

Bradley Bohrer - 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Capon Bridge Middle School

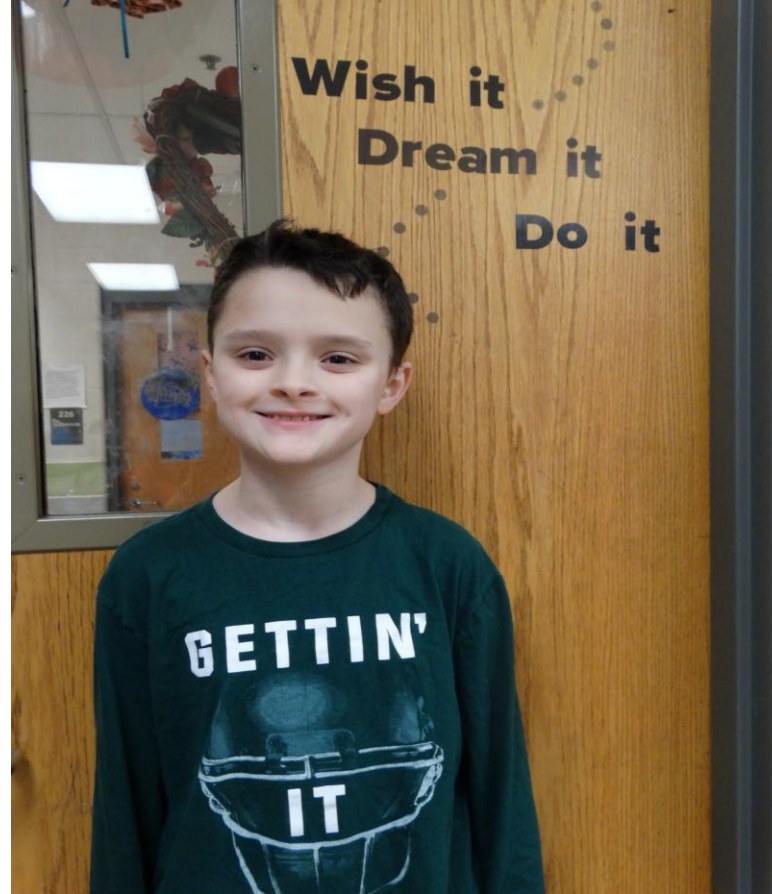
**Bradley** is conscientious, gets along well with his peers and works well with others.
