Districts needing more time to complete math and ELA testing due to limited device numbers (i.e., the number of computers available will require multiple groups for each test unit) may expand the math/ELA/CSLA test window and begin testing those content areas earlier for both CMAS and CoAlt. Please remember that **the extended window is ONLY for online math and ELA** (including CSLA) and that **ONLY** districts with limited device capacity are eligible to participate in the extended window.

4 weeks (science, social studies, ELA and math): April 1 – April 26, 2024 extended window

* In 2024, social studies assessments will not be administered on a sampling basis.

** For PSAT, each school will test on one of three available initial test dates. DACs may make a district-wide decision or may allow individual schools to select their initial test date. Starting in 2024, PSAT will use separate test forms for initial and make-up testing (similar to SAT).

****To the extent possible, high school students taking the alternate ELA/math assessments should be assessed using the same or similar schedule as students taking the PSAT/SAT and students taking the alternate science/social studies assessments should be assessed using the same or similar schedule as students taking CMAS.
