Harrisburg School District Restart Plan 2023 - 2024

INTRODUCTION

The Harrisburg School District will continue to work in collaboration with local, regional, state, and national resources throughout the school year to ensure the health and safety of our staff and students. Protocols and procedures may change quickly as conditions warrant. We recommend students and staff follow the most recent CDC recommendations for isolation and quarantine guidelines.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- The District encourages physical distancing throughout the school day and school activities.
- Frequent handwashing throughout the day, before and after eating, and after using shared equipment is recommended.
- Water bottles are highly recommended.
 Fill stations are available in every building.
- COVID-related extended absences will be addressed individually based on students' specific situations.
- Facilities will be regularly cleaned and maintained in accordance with guidelines set forth by the CDC.

NOTIFICATION PROCESS

 An online notification will be posted when there are five or more active cases in any given building.

+ SAFETY & WELL-BEING

- Staff and students should stay home while exhibiting symptoms of illness. It is recommended the symptomatic individual consult his/her healthcare provider for testing, guidance, and care.
- Families are encouraged to watch for symptoms at home.
- Staff members and students deemed to be close contacts outside of school through contact tracing completed by the South Dakota Department of Health, or who test positive for COVID, may be excluded from school in accordance with state guidelines. HSD will not perform internal contact tracing procedures beyond that completed by the DOH.
- It is recommended individuals eligible for the COVID vaccine consult their healthcare provider for questions and guidance.
- If an individual tests positive for COVID-19, please notify your school.

FACE COVERINGS

- Face masks will be available.
- Any students entering the health office who are exhibiting symptoms of illness will be required to wear a face covering.

+ SAFETY & WELL-BEING

The safety of our employees and students is our first priority. Facilities are cleaned and maintained in accordance with guidelines set forth by the CDC. The District is committed to protecting students and staff in order to reduce the risk of the spread of COVID-19.

- Establish Districtwide protocols for cleaning and disinfecting school facilities and equipment



TRANSPORTATION

- Buses will be disinfected.



CHILD NUTRITION

ACADEMICS
