From the Principal:

Greetings!

On behalf of the Harrisburg School District (HSD), we would like to remind you of the transition taking place for all middle school students during the 2023-2024 school year. Last school year, the Harrisburg School Board approved a single *learner centered pathway* that will replace the traditional and personalized learning pathways. As you prepare for this transition, we acknowledge the unknown can sometimes cause anxiety. Therefore, we would like to provide some basic information on this topic.

All HSD Middle Schools will implement a single Learner Centered Pathway, utilizing best practices rooted in the following:

Learning: the guarantee of a strong, viable curriculum with instruction that meets students where they are in their educational journey.

Agency: the building of self-efficacy and desire on the part of all learners and teachers to take action to improve their college and career readiness.

Character: the deliberate nurturing of learners to examine their decisions and responsibilities through the lens of empathy and understanding for all.

Relationships: the development of positive, growth focused interactions resulting in a strong sense of belonging and safety for everyone in the school community.

Common Scheduling: each middle school will have a single *learner-centered pathway*, built upon instructional best practices that integrate each of the characteristics listed above. This will require students to have schedule changes throughout the year.

As a result of adopting this pathway, each school will facilitate learning according to the principles described above.

With the transition to three middle schools this year, this is an exciting time to be in middle school. We look forward to the opportunity to work with each of you.




