

# Students and faculty should be excluded from school and School activities for the following conditions:

<b>Diarrhea/vomiting:</b> exclude if occurs 2 or more times in 24 hours or accompanied by a fever Exceptions for vomiting that is caused by a non-communicable condition if child is not at risk fo dehydration.
Influenza and Influenza-like illness: exclude until fever has been absent for 24 hours in an unmedicated state. Additional exclusions may be necessary for documented novel strain or pandemic influenza based on SD Department of Health and CDC guidance.
<b>Strep throat and Streptococcal skin infections:</b> exclude until after 12 hours of antibiotic treatment.
<b>Rash:</b> undiagnosed rash should be evaluated by a provider. Open sores and a suspicious contagious condition should be cleared by a provider.
<b>COVID-19:</b> the HSD recommends following the guidance provided by the CDC and SD Department of Health at <b>doh.sd.gov</b> . To report a student with a positive Covid test result contact your school attendance office at 743-2567 ext. 3007.
<b>Fever of 100.0 or greater</b> : exclude until fever has been absent for 24 hours without use of fever reducing medication.
<b>Persistent abdominal pain</b> : (continues for >2 hours) or intermittent abdominal pain associated with fever, dehydration, or other systemic symptoms.

## 2023-2024 Activities Participation

For Parents and Athletes entering Grades 7-12 as well as those entering Grade 6 who plan to participate in Cross Country or Wrestling:

The South Dakota High School Activities Association (SDHSAA) and the Harrisburg School District require certification as to the adequacy of a student's health for athletic participation.

- This certification shall be restricted to a duly licensed Doctor of Medicine, Doctor of Osteopathy, Doctor of Chiropractic, licensed physician's assistant, or licensed nurse practitioner.
- All exams must be signed by authorized medical personnel as listed above.
- Stamping the name of a medical clinic or a medical association as a substitute for the Doctor's signature is unacceptable.
- Physicals taken in the spring for the ensuing school term shall be taken after April 1.
  - o For example, a physical taken on or after April 1, 2023, is valid for the 2023-24 school year.
  - A physical taken on March 1, 2023, expires on July 1, 2023, and is **NOT** valid for the 2023-24 school year.

To meet the requirements of the SDHSAA and the District, please follow the steps below. Once all steps are complete you are cleared to participate. Again, this process MUST be completed, and forms MUST be submitted to the HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES OFFICE prior to the first day of your sport's season.

Please complete these steps prior to the first day of practice to be cleared to participate in your activity!

**Step 1: Athletes** fill out the <u>Pre-participation Physical Evaluation HISTORY FORM.</u> Take the *HISTORY FORM* and the *SDHSAA PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FORM* to an authorized medical provider (listed above) for a physical exam.

**Step 2: Athletes and Parents** fill out the <u>Parental and Student Medical Consent and Concussion</u> <u>Awareness Forms</u> required by the SDHSAA and the District.

**Step 3:** Once you have you have completed **Steps 1 & 2**, you may submit the forms in one of two ways:

- Turn in ALL forms to the Harrisburg High School Office. (DO NOT turn forms in at any Middle School or Elementary School Office!)

# 6<sup>th</sup> GRADE REQUIREMENTS

South Dakota law requires all 6<sup>th</sup> grade students to get:

One dose of Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine on or after the 11<sup>th</sup> birthday

One dose of Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine on or after the 11<sup>th</sup> birthday

Please provide your child's immunization record to the nurse no later than October 1, 2022. Your child may be denied entry to school if these immunizations are not completed. If you are in need of an exemption form, please contact Deb Backman, at 743-2567 ext. 5205.

## What is Canvas?

Think of Canvas LMS (Learning Management System) as your student's digital classroom. It's a simple, supportive system where schools provide lessons and communication to 6-12 students and parents to keep the learning going strong-both in the classroom and online.



### **Get Connected**

For parents to "connect" with their student's account, the student must generate a Pairing Code. Codes are for one "observer", (parent/quardian) only. If a second parent wants to access, a second pairing code must be generated by the student.


