Quarter 1-Grades

Your learner's first quarter grades are now available to view on Canvas by accessing your parent Canvas account. Please take a moment with your learner to review his/her grades. Each course assesses learner progress on the standards of learning for that course. If you have questions about your learner's progress, please communicate those with the classroom teacher.

Grades are as up-to-date as possible to serve as a snapshot of your learner's progress in Harrisburg Middle School's year-long, standard-based grading

policy. As a reminder, a learner has a grade for each standard, and each learner is held accountable for <u>each standard in each class</u>. Please know that any standard that is not 70% or higher may result in zero hour.

Feel free to reach out to your child's teacher regarding failing standards and ways learners can recover their grades. It is important that learners work hard and give school their very best to recover any failing grades or to maintain passing grades.

If you would prefer a paper copy of your learner's grades, please contact the HSMS Administrative Assistant (Kristin Krueger), by calling 743.2567 ext. 3007. If you have not yet set up a Canvas account, I encourage you to do so.

General reminder about MS grades:

MS uses standards-based grading. This means students receive multiple grades for each course, one grade for each district standard. Any standard below 70%, is "Standard Not Met" and needs to be addressed in order to pass the course. Grades can be viewed through Canvas by logging into the district Canvas website: https://harrisburgsd.instructure.com/

Options for how to view grades for MS Students:

- 1. Login to Canvas in a browser using a parent/observer account (Video Walkthrough)
- 2. Login to Canvas from the Parent app (Video Walkthrough)
- 3. Ask your student to login to Canvas on a browser and show you their grades (<u>Video</u> walkthrough)

Introducing ZERO HOUR

ZERO HOUR IS A QUARTERLY OPPORTUNITY FOR LEARNERS TO RECOVER THEIR STANDARDS THAT WON'T BE ADDRESSED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE YEAR.

- Step 1: Teachers/Teams will contact you if your learner is eligible for Zero Hour
- Step 2: Eligible Learners will attend Zero
 Hour from either 7:30am-8:24a
 or 3:04pm-4:00pm
- Step 3: Learners will attend Zero Hour for up to 2 weeks or until they have recovered their standards
- Step 4: Attendance and completion will be communicated by administration

Add Funds to Lunch Account

My School Bucks is an online service that allows parents to do any of the following:

- Ask to be alerted when a child's meal account balance runs below an amount the parent sets.
- Apply money to student meal accounts using a credit/debit card or electronic check.

Tutor Program and Student Help

At South Middle School, we offer a variety of different programs to help learners who struggle or need more work time to complete assignments. These programs include:

Power Hour

Power Hour is held every afternoon from 3:05pm-4:00pm and every morning from 7:30am-8:00am.

Success Advisory and Success Directed Study

We assign learners to Success Advisory and Success Directed Study, where they develop study skills and plan to get and stay caught up in school.

Attendance

If your learner is going to be absent or late for school, call the school office at 605-743-2567 ext. 3007 **before 9:00AM daily**. Or email smsattendance@harrisburg.k12.sd.us. If your learner is going to be out for an extended period of time and/or you would like classwork for the day, please let the office know about attendance and contact your learner's advisory teacher for missing work.
