SCHOOL FUNDING POLICY

School finance decisions must put student achievement first. Western Dubuque supports SSA increases that ensure equity, stability, efficiency, and local control, providing predictable, timely resources to recruit and retain staff and meet student needs in a high-quality education system.



PRIVATE SCHOOL CHOICE

Iowa already provides ample educational choice. Additional tax credits or funding for nonpublic options divert resources from public schools. Any private-school expansion must meet public standards for transparency, equity, and responsible use of taxpayer dollars.



MENTAL HEALTH

Rising mental health needs are directly impacting student success. We support comprehensive school and community systems that expand access to qualified providers, sustain therapeutic classrooms, strengthen partnerships, fund staff training and suicide prevention, and ensure reliable, dedicated resources so students and educators receive the support they need.
