Jersey 100 Inclement Weather Communication for Parents/Guardians 2023-24

As we transition to colder weather, Jersey CUSD 100 would like to communicate with parents/guardians regarding the plan for days of inclement weather. The District has included five emergency (snow) days in the school calendar. The District will not be utilizing E-learning days this school year.

Please know that a final decision for a change in normal operations on inclement weather days is made by the superintendent. You will receive a notification by 5:30 a.m. Exceptions may occur on days when weather or road conditions change rapidly during the morning hours.

School officials consult several sources to evaluate road conditions throughout the county. While many of the main roadways may be clear, officials also have to evaluate the back roads to determine their conditions. Please know the safety of students and staff is the number one priority when deciding to close schools.

Parents are encouraged to use their judgment to determine what is best for their children. Parents and guardians should notify their child's school of any absence.

Jersey CUSD 100 may utilize a delayed two-hour start when adverse weather conditions are present. This would most often be used when the weather has caused poor driving conditions early in the morning, but then is projected to clear off within a few hours. On those delayed start days Jersey CUSD 100 will simply begin school two hours later than normal. This means that buses will run two hours later (if your child is normally picked up at 7:00 a.m. they will be picked up at 9:00 a.m.). Breakfast will not be served, and morning classes for Early Childhood, PreKindergarten, and Early Bird (JCHS) will not be in session. Dismissal times will remain the same.
