IS NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR A COMMITTEE MEMBER

The Town of Eagar has one opening on its Local Board for the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System- Round Valley Fire and Medical Department. This is a volunteer citizen position and a good opportunity to serve your community.

For background, the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System (PSPRS) Local Board is required by Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-847 for those entities with members in the PSPRS. The PSPRS Local Board meets at least two times per year, and its members are appointed for four (4) year terms. The PSPRS Local Board responsibilities include the following:

- Decide member eligibility, disability and line-of-duty death benefits
- Apply all statutory requirements for member eligibility and benefits
- Do not change, subtract from or add to statutory plan benefits
- Use discretion, consider impact on members, beneficiaries and financial status of plan
- Request information from employers and members as necessary
- Make timely decisions under 90-day statutory requirement
- Allow rehearing's Model Uniform Rules for resolving disputes
- Appoint independent medical board with designated physician(s), must be MD
- Use "care, skill and caution," exercise "good faith" and avoid conflicts of interest
