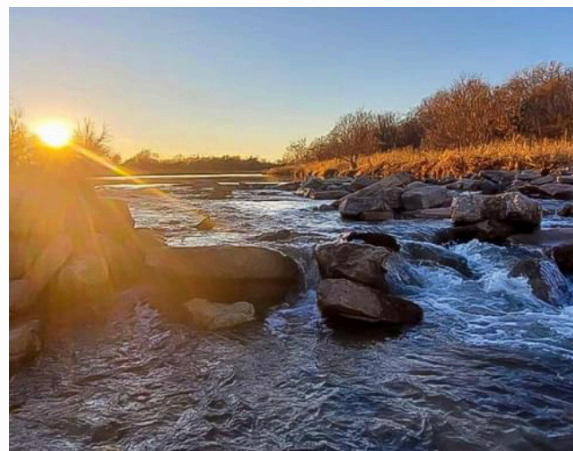




Visitors Guide

TOP 10 THINGS TO SEE & DO IN KINGMAN

-  **Kingman Historic Theatre**
Enjoy first-run movies, amazing concerts, or take a tour of this historic theatre located in the heart of downtown.
-  **Cessna Fest**
Celebrate rural pioneering spirit with live music, shopping, kids activities and much more the third Saturday in September.
-  **Art & Music on Main**
Listen to music and search for eight murals in the downtown district. Snap a picture of the Planes on the Plains sculpture.
-  **Historic Building Walking Tour**
Kingman's downtown corridor has six buildings on the National Register of historic places, and a seventh on the state registry.
-  **Lighted Christmas Parade**
This long-standing annual event is held the first Saturday in December. Activities are scheduled throughout the day and evening.
-  **Heritage Hall & Veterans Memorial**
Anchoring the north and south ends of the downtown corridor, these public displays memorialize current and former Kingmanites.
-  **Kingman County Historic Museum**
Learn about Kingman County's history in Kingman's former City Hall and Fire Station with its original hose drying tower on display.
-  **Cattleman's Picnic & Carnival**
As part of the Kingman County Fair the last weekend in July, the Cattleman's Picnic honors Kingman's rich rodeo history.
-  **City of Kingman Park System**
Kingman's five parks offer an array of activities including fishing, camping, playground equipment, splashpad, and event space.
-  **Fourth of July Family Fest**
Located in Riverside Park on Independence Day, all-day family-friendly activities conclude with a fireworks display at dark.
