INFORMATION FOR PART-TIME CLASSES

WITHDRAWAL:

If you need to withdraw from a part-time course, all but a \$10 processing fee will be refunded. **Withdrawals must be made fewer than three (3) business days before the class is scheduled to begin.** No tuition will be refunded if a student withdraws within 3 days of the scheduled start of class or after the class has started.

BOOKS:

All books, supplies, and other materials are included in the course cost. Books will be available in the Adult Education Office. The student is responsible for basic tools required. Some exceptions are noted in the course description.

CERTIFICATES & CEUs:

A Certificate of Completion will be awarded to each student who attends **90%** of scheduled part-time classes and satisfactorily completes the course. CEUs are calculated at .1 CEU for every hour spent in class. The student receives the original certificate and the school does not keep a copy. Duplicates can be issued at a cost of \$10.

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CLASS CANCELLATION:

Buckeye Career Center reserves the right to change course locations, schedules, fees, and instructors, or to cancel or delay the start date of any course. Should a cancellation become necessary, fees in full will be refunded by check. Allow 3 weeks for refund to process.

SCHOOL CLOSINGS:

Adult classes may still operate even though the high school has closed. Adult classes will meet regularly as scheduled. If conditions require closings, announcements will be posted on our website and social media accounts after 12 noon for our afternoon full-time classes and part-time classes. Announcements will also be on WTUZ 99.9 FM, WJER 1450 AM, or WJER 100.9 FM.

FEES:

Full payment of fees is due at the time of registration. Registration fees can be paid by cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, or Discover. Make check payable to Buckeye Career Center. Any outstanding balances must be paid in full before registration is allowed for a new class.

VETERANS & SENIOR CITIZENS - 25% DISCOUNT AT REGISTRATION:

Veterans and persons over the age of 60 will receive a 25% discount on tuition for some of our part-time vocational classes with proof of age or DD214 papers. This discount is for tuition only and is not valid for books and supplies. Ask the Adult Education Office about eligible classes. Tuition discount must be requested at time of registration.

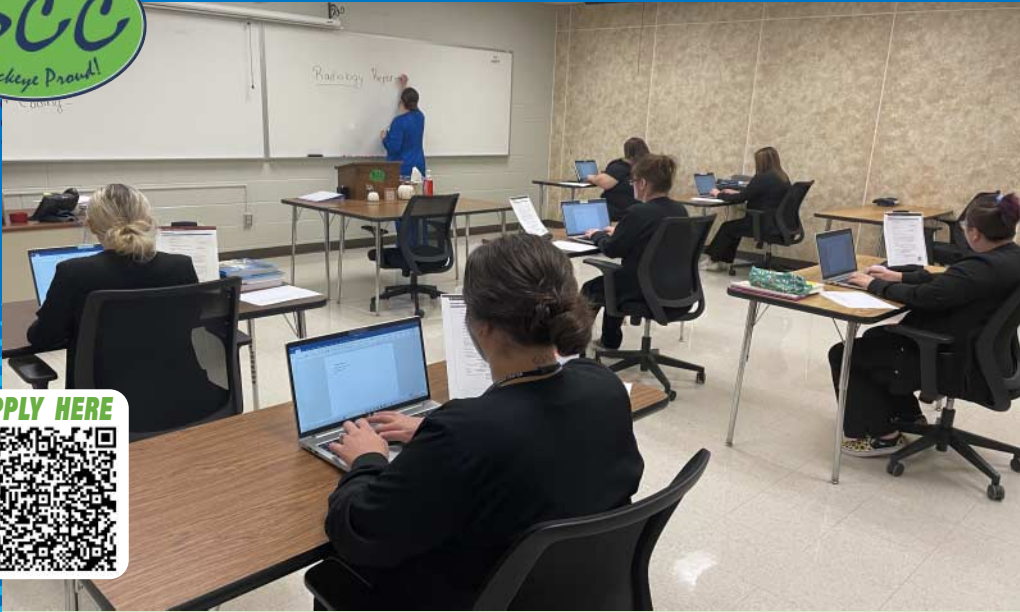

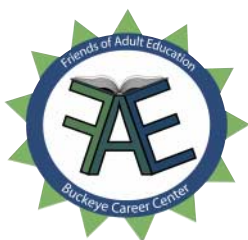
