Financial Fortitude

We have the strength, resilience, and confidence to navigate our financial landscape so that the dollars we spend are aligned to our vision and mission

We invested \$865,000 in a new track and grand stand for the 2025-2026 school year. The city of Broomfield contributed \$315,000 toward this project as part of our shared use agreement and we are grateful for their partnership. The poured concrete is currently curing until August 25th and we will then spend 3 weeks of surfacing the track area. We are anticipating completion of the surfacing during the week of September 14, 2025.

The installation of the new drainage on the turf has also begun and is expected to be completed by August 25th.

Our grandstand footers will be poured within the next two weeks and we anticipate the installation of the grandstands to occur the beginning of October. With an approximate installation completion date for the grandstands in mid-October.

The biggest impact to our community this fall is that we will not have our field available for gym classes, lunch and our sports. However we do believe the long term benefit will truly outweigh the challenges that we have faced during this project.
