## AUTHORIZED USE OF SCHOOL-OWNED MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT

School equipment shall not be used for personal or commercial use.

School equipment may be lent to community groups for educational, civic or charitable purposes when:

- 1. The group borrowing the equipment agrees to accept responsibility for repairing or replacing any equipment damaged or lost while in its possession.
- 2. The equipment is not expensive and subject to easy damage.
- 3. The equipment is in good working condition.
- 4. The group will provide a competent operator for any machine lent.
- 5. Outside use of the equipment will not interfere with the school program.

Any student or other individual borrowing school equipment must sign an official receipt through the principal's office. A deposit may be required as determined by the principal or superintendent.
