

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION IN PRIVATE VEHICLES

Staff members and other approved personnel may transport a student or group of students in their own vehicle for school-related purposes when they have authorization to do so.

Special permission for providing student transportation may be granted by the principal. Personnel with authorization to use their own vehicles must carry liability insurance coverage in compliance with state law. Use of private vehicles, when approved shall be reimbursed at the school district adopted rate.
